The prevalence estimates for QN16 and QN17 were incorrect. The prevalence estimates have been corrected and now reflect the summary text descriptions below:

QN16: “Among students who were seriously injured during the past 12 months, the percentage whose most serious injury happened to them while they were playing or training for a sport.”

QN17: “Among students who were seriously injured during the past 12 months, the percentage whose most serious injury was the result of a fall.”

The summary text for QNMINPAG and QNWKRDG has been improved as follows:

QNMINPAG: “Percentage of students who were physically active for at least 60 minutes per day on less than five days per week on average.”

QNWKRDG: “Percentage of students who spent less than 2.5 hours total walking or riding a bicycle to and from school during the past seven days.”
