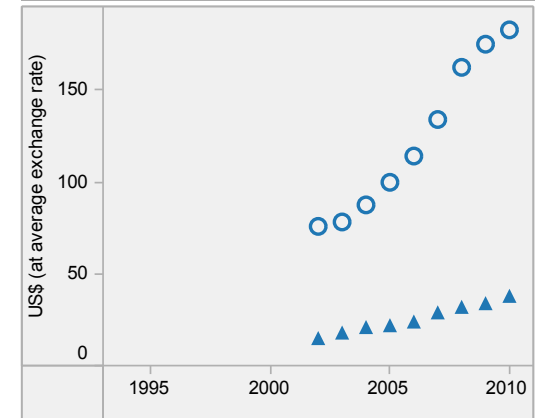

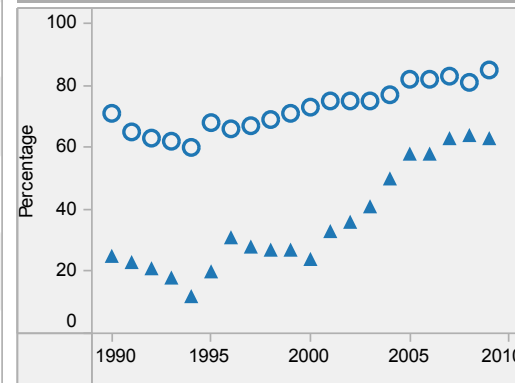

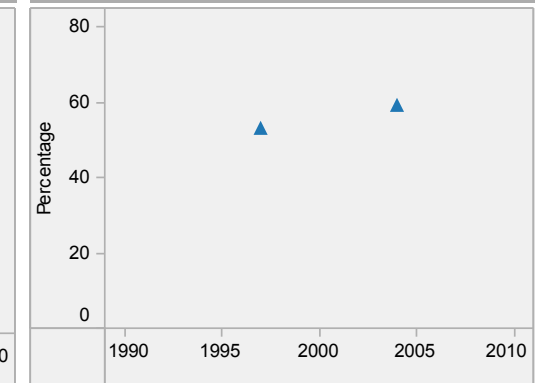
Per capita total expenditure on health



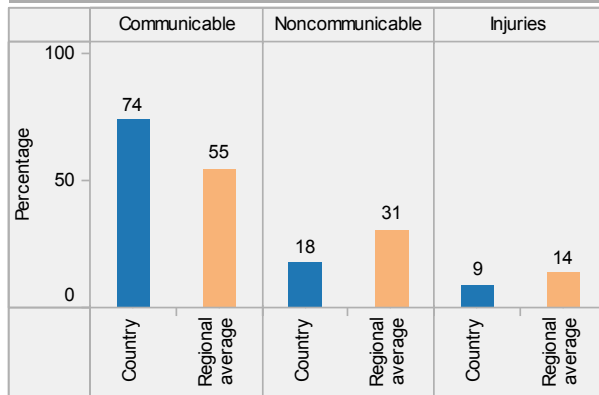
DTP3 immunization among 1-year-olds



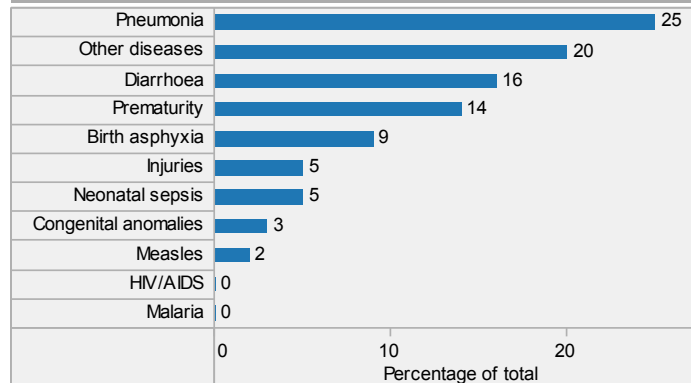
Children aged under-5 stunted



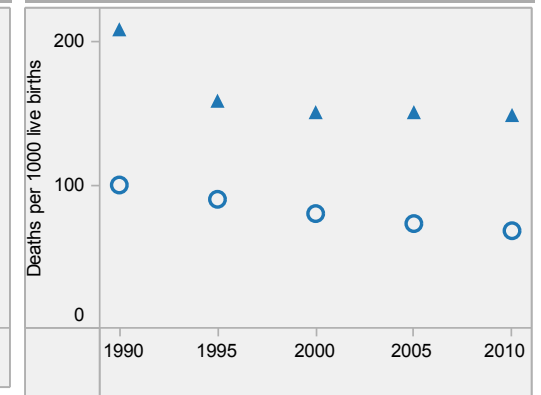
Distribution of years of life lost by causes (2008)



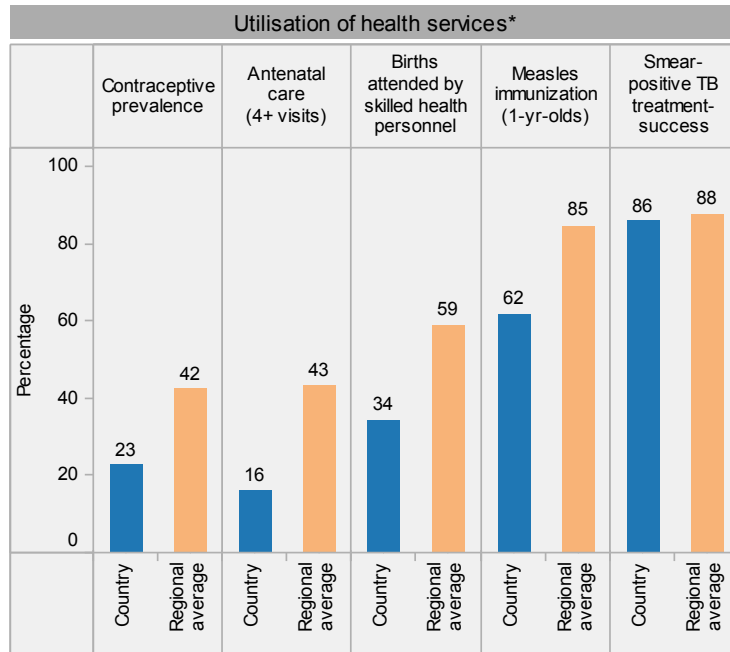
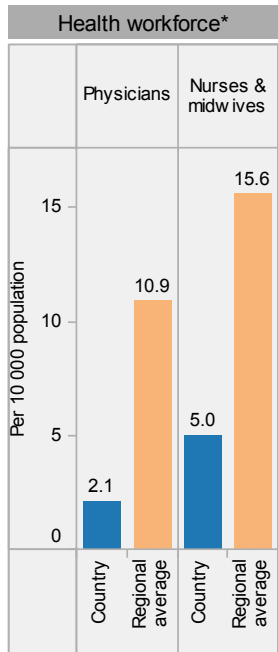
Distribution of causes of deaths in children under-5 (2010)



Under-5 mortality rate

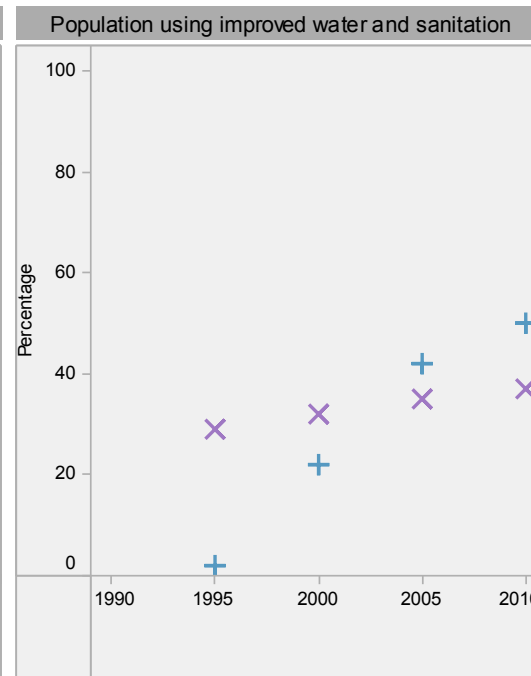
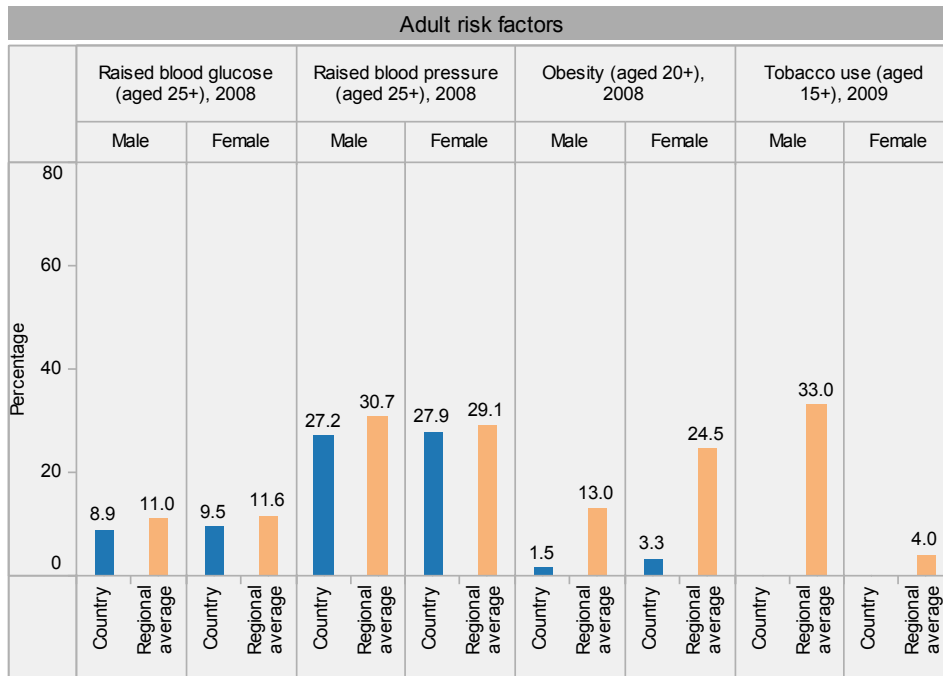
