The idea of the eradication of the Guinea worm disease was launched in the early 1980s

- Guinea worm disease was then considered as the first candidate to eradication after other unsuccessful ventures (i.e. malaria).
- Ideology had changed after Alma Ata (1978)
- The emphasis was put on community health, and non medical sanitary measures
- The eradication of the Guinea worm disease fitted well into this new context
- Role of the Foundation of President Carter, to be explored
