Background

The Outpatient Mortality and Morbidity Weekly Surveillance system collects information on priority communicable diseases from all actors (MOH, local and international NGOs and other agencies) involved in health care activities in the 6 districts affected by the earthquake in Yogyakarta and Central Java provinces. It aims at monitoring the epidemiological situation in order to rapidly detect, verify, investigate and control outbreaks of communicable diseases requiring public health interventions.

Activity and mortality indicators

There were 11.439 consultations in week 32 of 2006, 4.935 new cases. No death cases reported

EPIDEMIOLOGICAL ALERTS

Cholera: No cholera cases have been confirmed in the affected areas

Tetanus: No tetanus case has been reported in the affected areas

- The total number of tetanus cases is 54 in Jogjakarta Province and 21 have died (CFR 38,8%)

Bloody diarrhoea: Two reported case from Kulon Progo, 1 reported case from Bantul, 1 reported case from Gunungkidul, and 3 reported case from Sleman. No laboratory evaluation was done.

Typhoid fever: Five reported cases were reported from Sleman (3 cases), Bantul (1 case) and Yogyakarta City (1 case)

Dengue haemorrhagic fever: One case reported from Kulonprogo

Pneumonia: Six cases have been reported from Gunungkidul (2 cases) and Yogyakarta City (4 cases)

Measles: 2 suspected cases reported, each from Kulonprogo and Sleman

EPIDEMIOLOGICAL ALERTS

Cholera: No cholera cases have been confirmed in the affected areas

Tetanus: 32 cases found in Klaten and 12 have died (CFR= 37,5%)

Bloody diarrhoea: 5 cases were reported, 1 below 5 years old, 4 cases \geq 5 years old

Measles: One clinical case \geq 5 y.o. was reported. No blood sample taken
