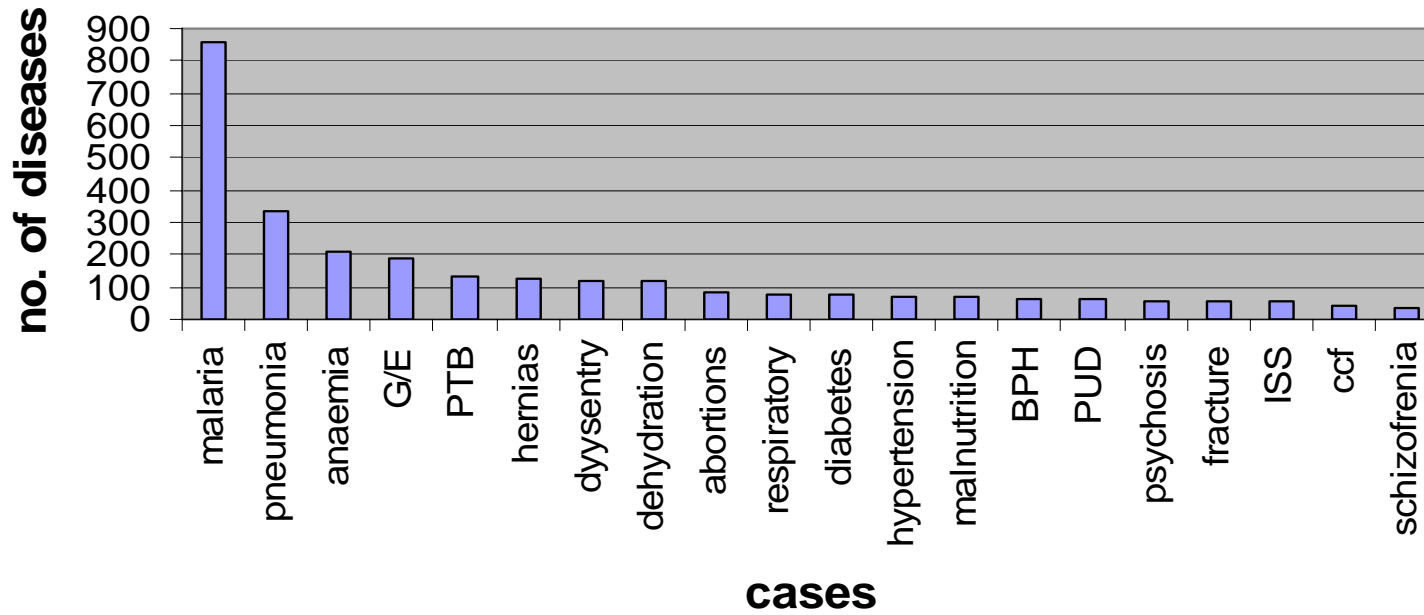

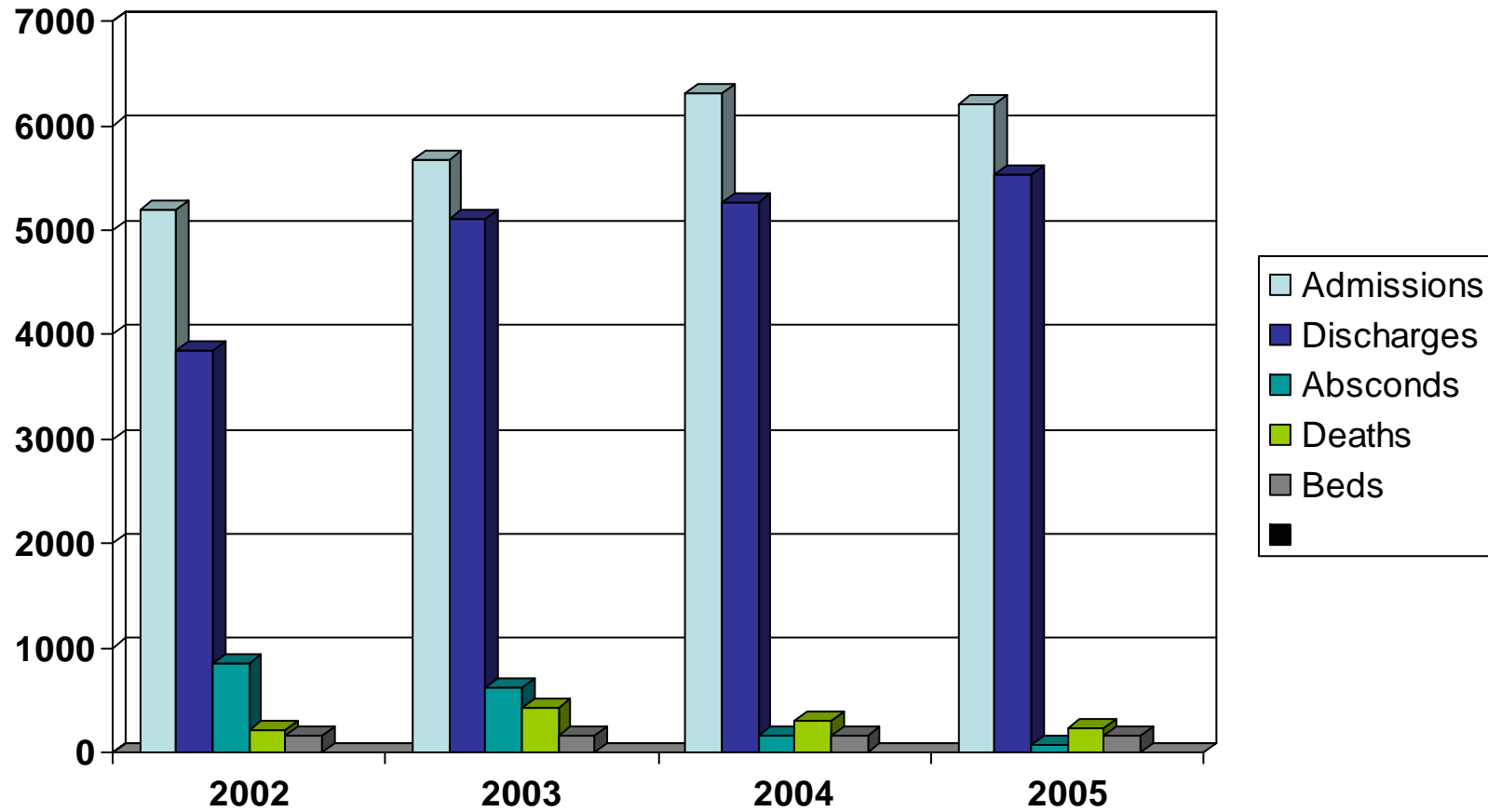

top 20 causes of inpatient morbidity



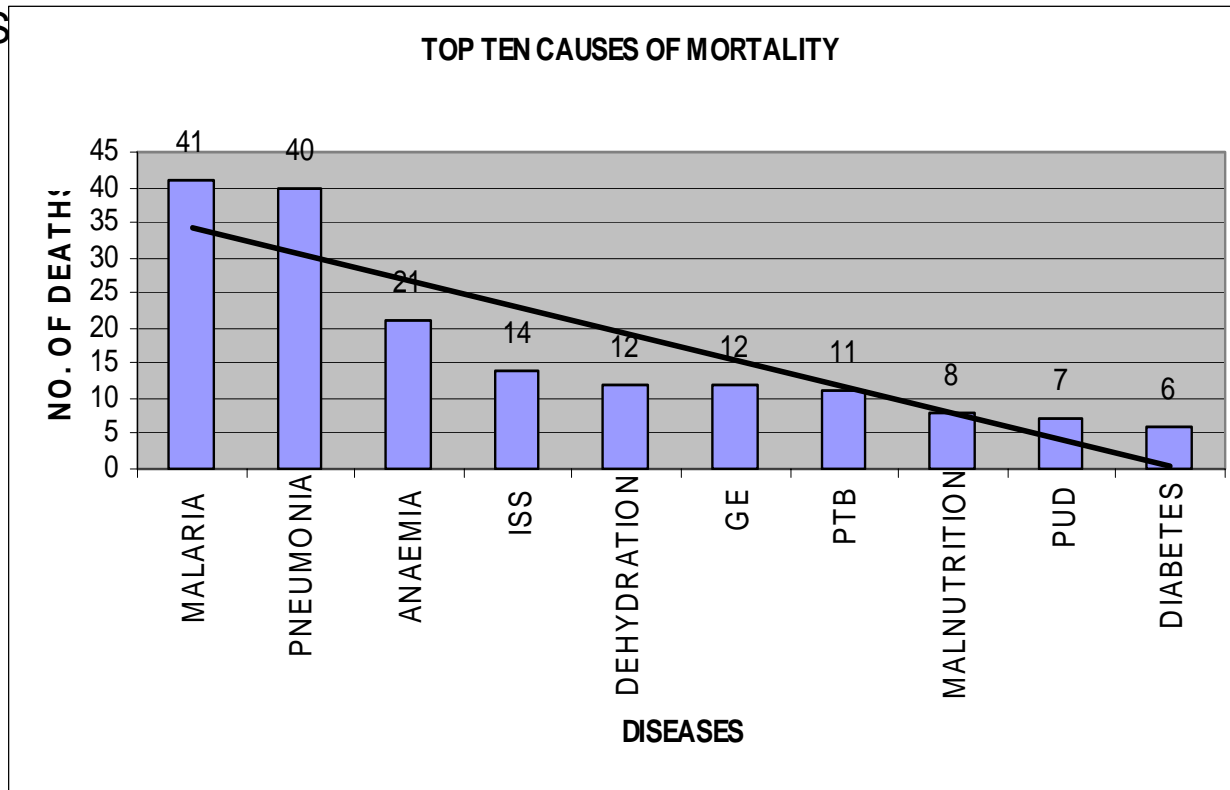
INPATIENT STATISTICS TREND

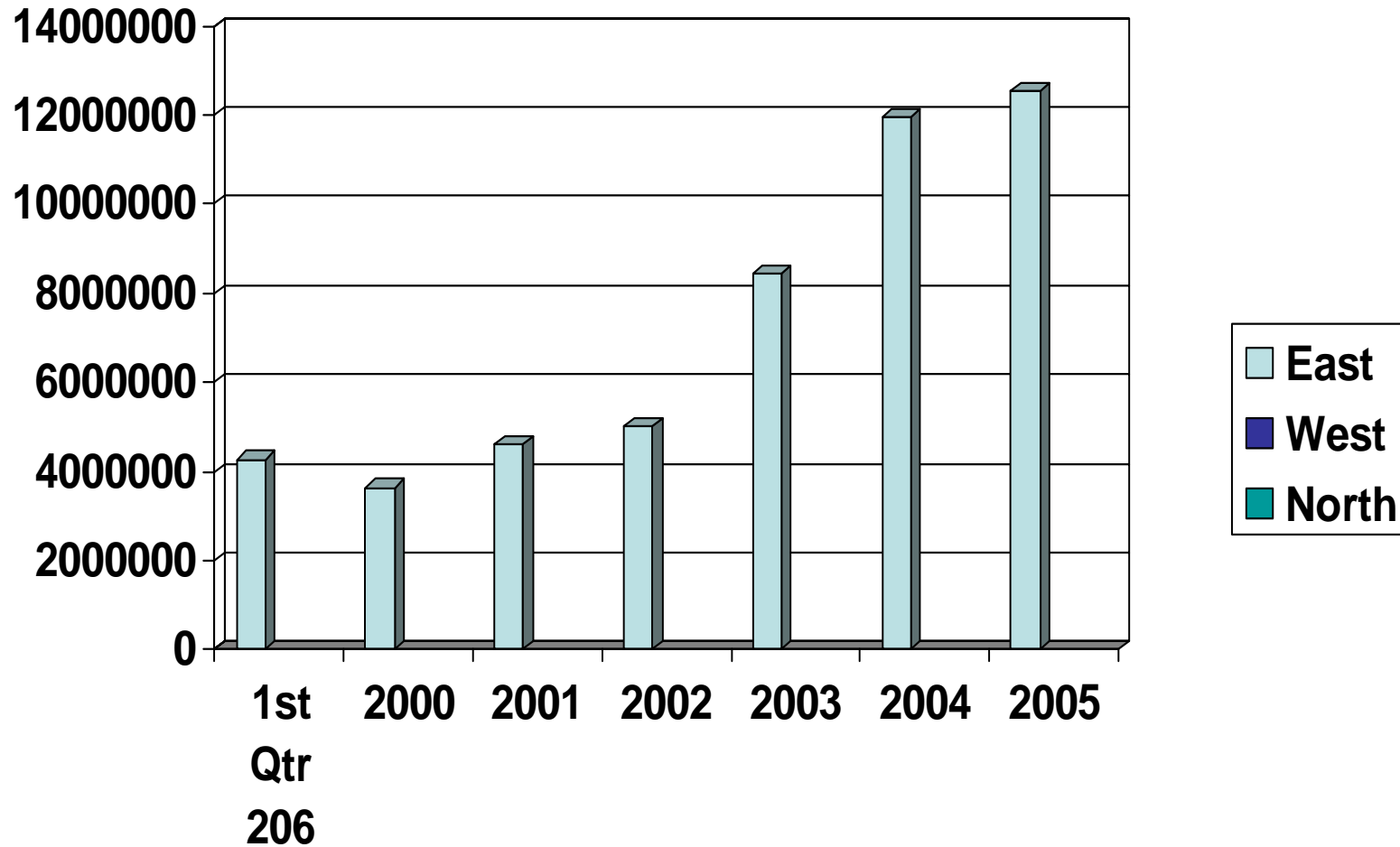

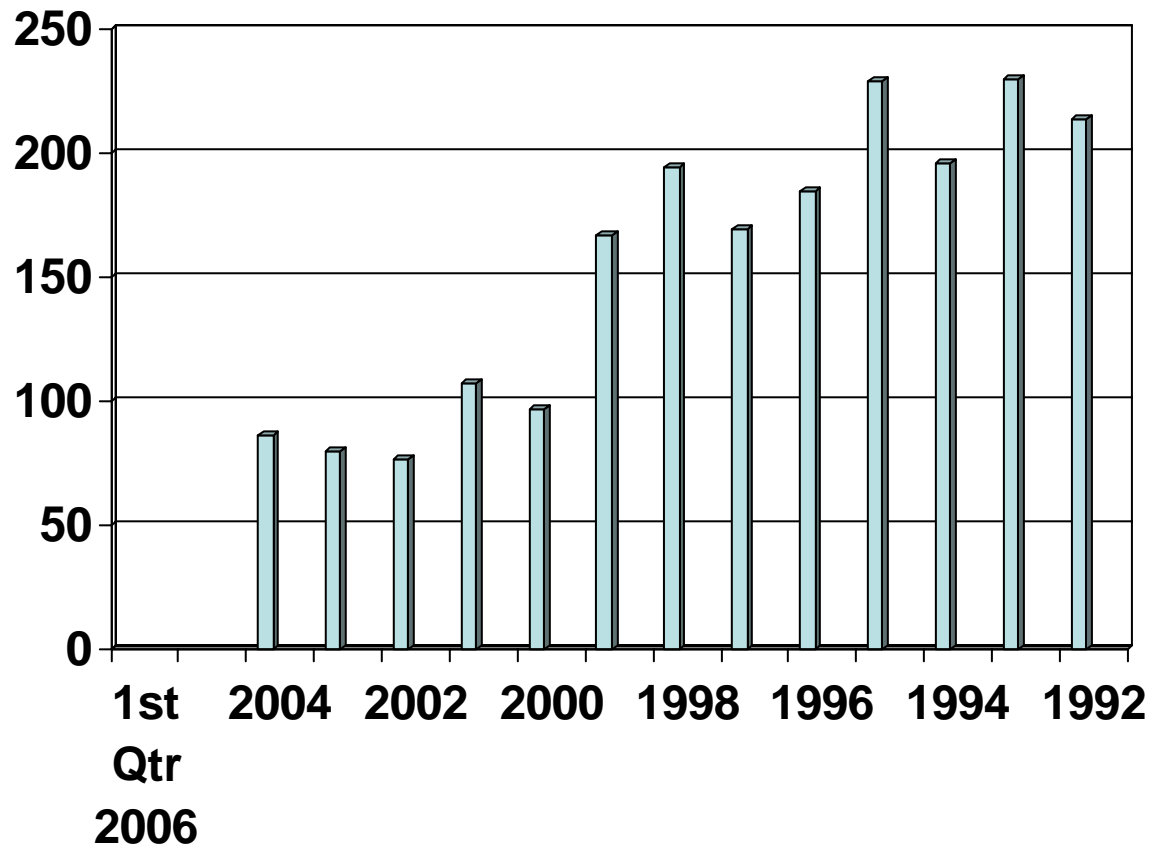
COST SHARING TRENDS INCLUSIVE 1ST QUARTER 2006



CONSTRAINS

- STAFFING –shortage in number and skills
 - high staff turnover
 - poor retention ability for special doctors and consultants
 - Lack of essential specialties e.g. pathologists, psychiatrists, radiologist
- REFFERAL SYSTEM –Transport-maintenance and lack
