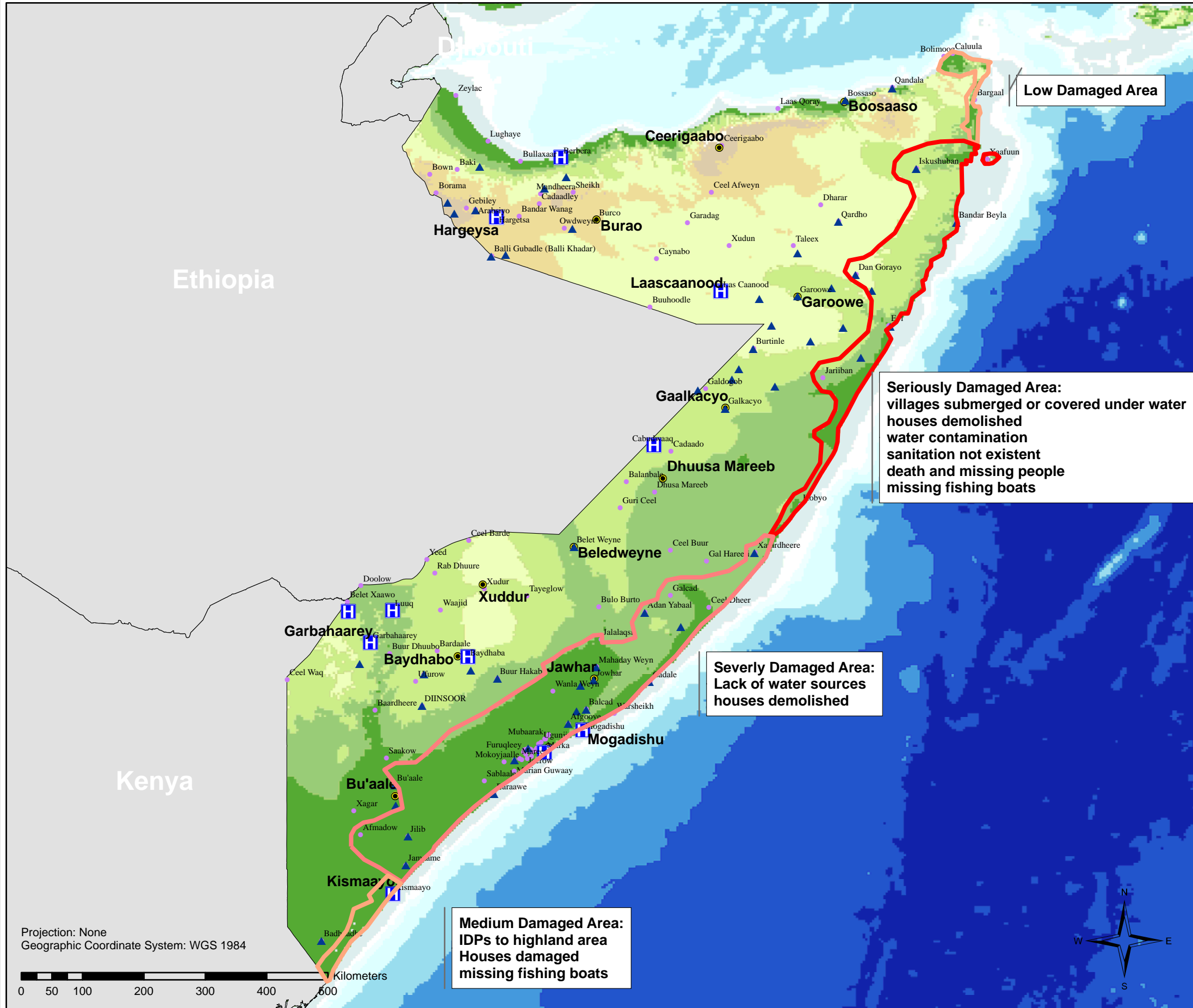




Somalia: Extent of Affected Areas due to Tsunami
