

## Health and Human Rights Course held in Ulaanbaatar (Mongolia) on 27 & 28 November, 2008

On 27 & 28 November 2008, the Regional Office for Western Pacific and WHO's Mongolia Office organized a Health and Human Rights training course in Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia. The course was attended by a total of 15 participants who were drawn from the WHO CO, the Ministry of Health of Mongolia, the Health Sciences University of Mongolia, UNFPA Mongolia and four of the referral Hospitals in Ulaanbaatar. The OIC WR of WHO Mongolia CO, who attended the full session of the course, opened the course by welcoming participants of the course. The course covered issues such as the meaning of human rights and the different mechanisms for their protection, the right to health, the meaning and contents of the right to health, the meaning and key steps of HRBA and the health and human rights mandate of WHO as well as protection of the right to health in Mongolia.
