

A new Hinari Master trainer course will be available for free to users in registered institutions. This two-week distance learning course focuses on the basic skills needed to effectively access and download full-text material from the Hinari resources and also how to complete keyword searches in Hinari/PubMed and Summon.

The course will take 5-7 hours to complete including the hands-on activities. After the instructors review of the submitted exercises, recipients will receive a certificate upon successful completion of the course.
