



**Yves Souteyrand
Coordinator a.i.

Yves Souteyrand, PhD, is the Coordinator a.i. of the Strategic Information unit in WHO's HIV Department in Geneva, a post he was appointed to in April 2004 after serving, since October 2003, as Senior Advisor to the Director of the Department.

Dr Souteyrand is an economist trained in health economics. A national of France, he received his PhD from the University of Aix en Provence. He worked at the French Ministry of Health as a researcher in charge of implementing research programmes in public health and health systems research. Recruited by the National Medical and Health Research Institute (INSERM), he was appointed between 1993 and 2003, by the French National Agency for AIDS Research (ANRS), as the Head of Public Health and Socio- behavioural AIDS Research.

Dr Souteyrand was coordinator of a wide range of research programmes in France and in low- and middle-income countries. He created an observatory to monitor and evaluate HIV/AIDS response to prevention programmes in France. He has been the principal investigator of the evaluation of the Chilean UNAIDS Drug Access Initiative and was an investigator of a similar programme for Cote d'Ivoire. He coordinated the ANRS task force on Economic Evaluation of Treatment in low and mid-income countries (ETAPSud).

Dr Souteyrand has published a number of articles on socio-behavioural and economic issues of HIV/AIDS. He is the co-editor of *Economics of AIDS and Access to HIV/AIDS Treatment. Issues and challenges* (Paris, ANRS,2003).
