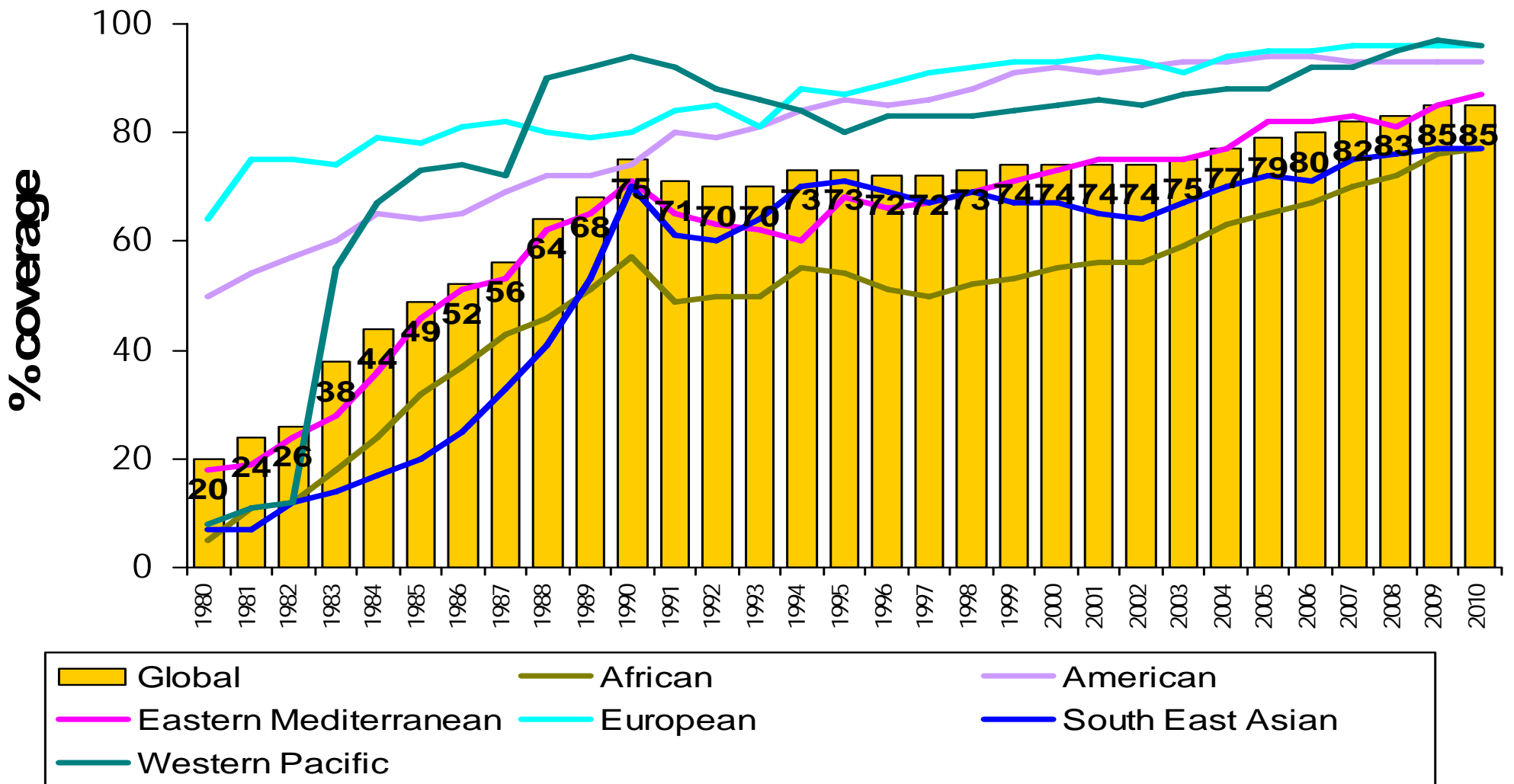

global coverage at 85% in 2010

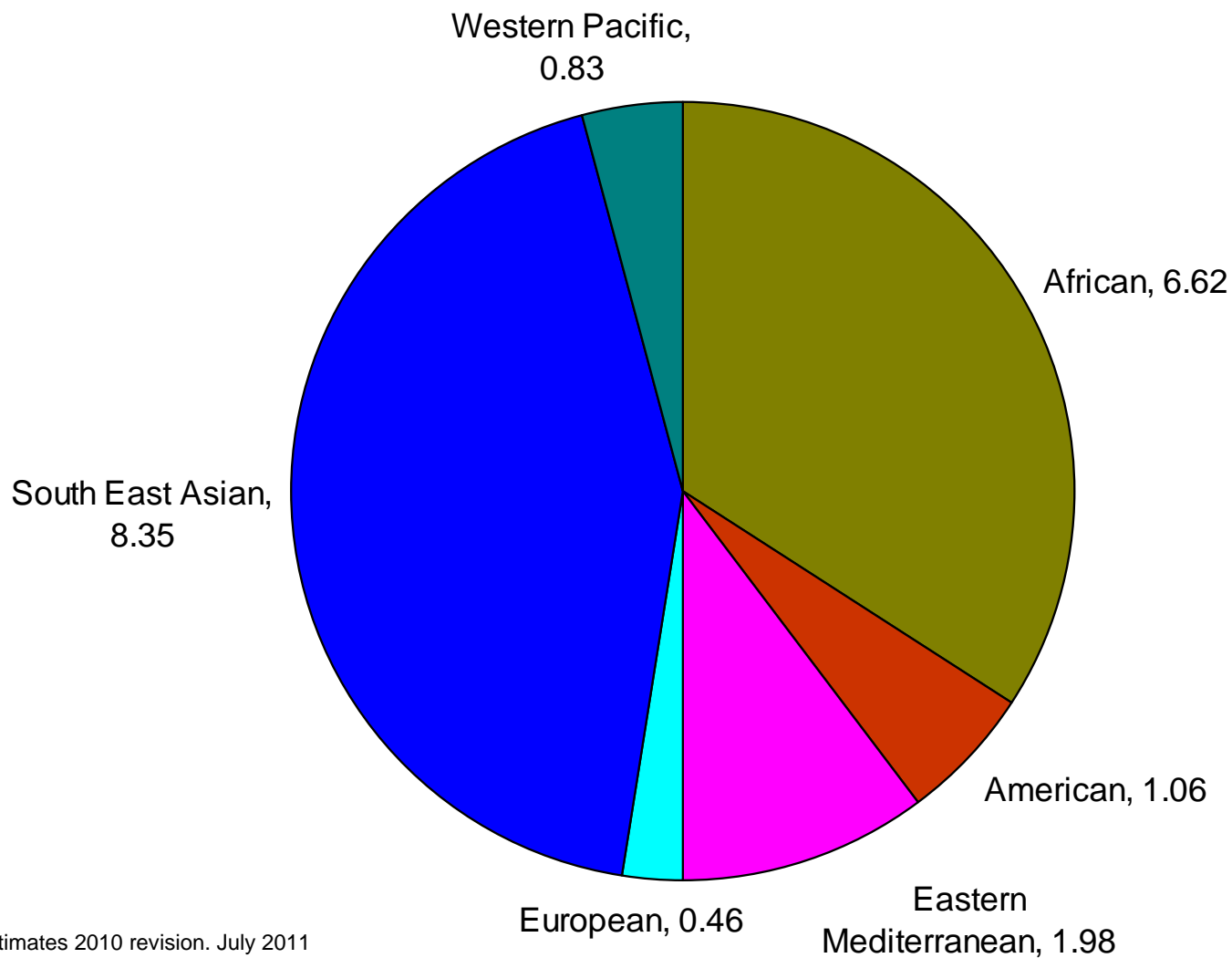

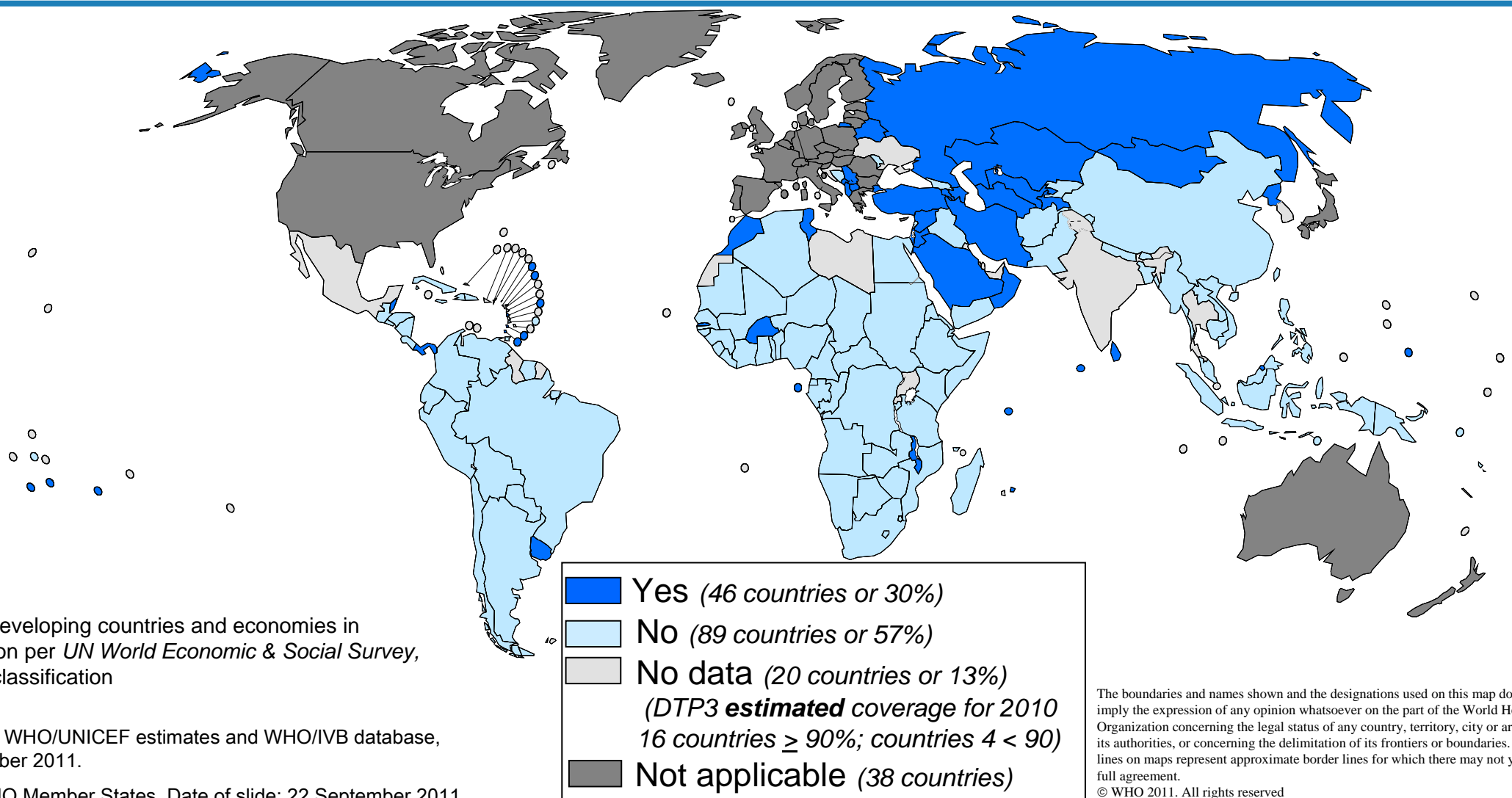

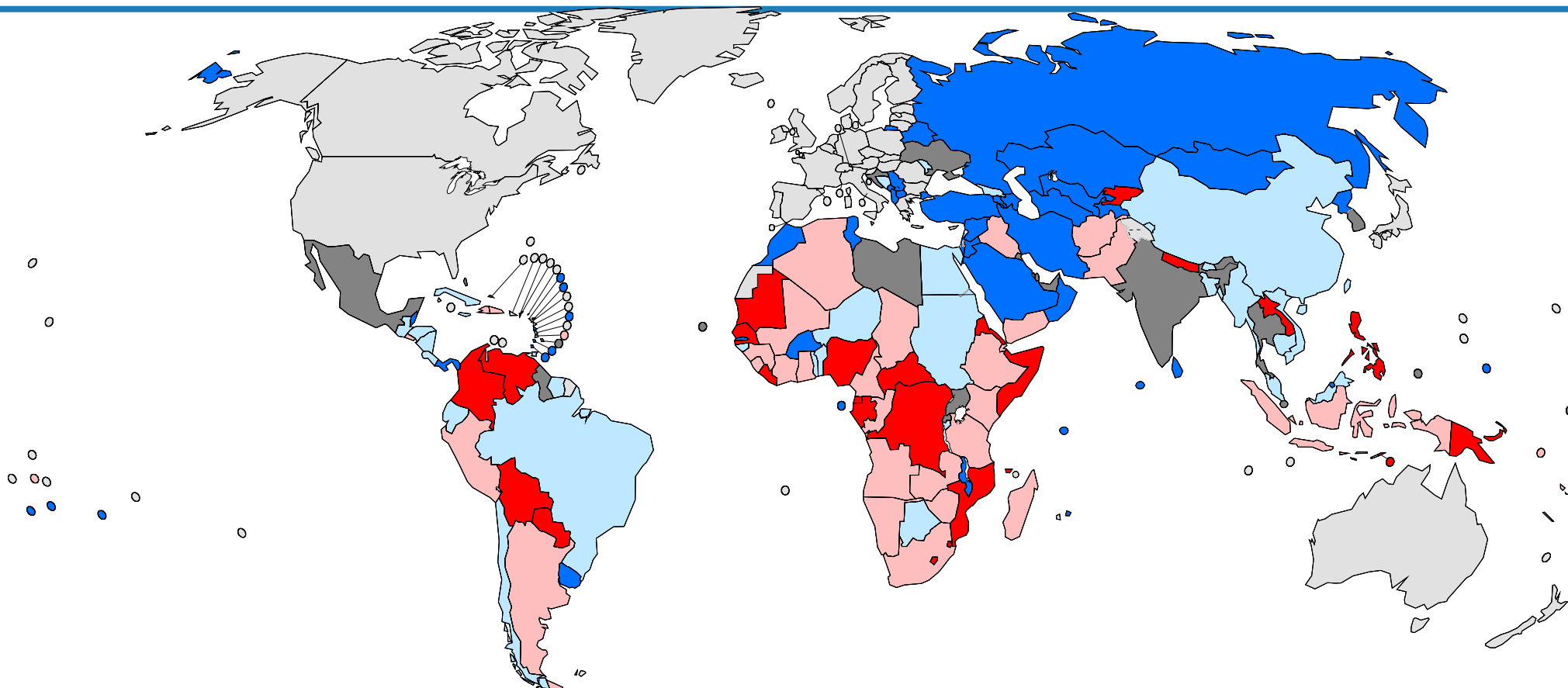

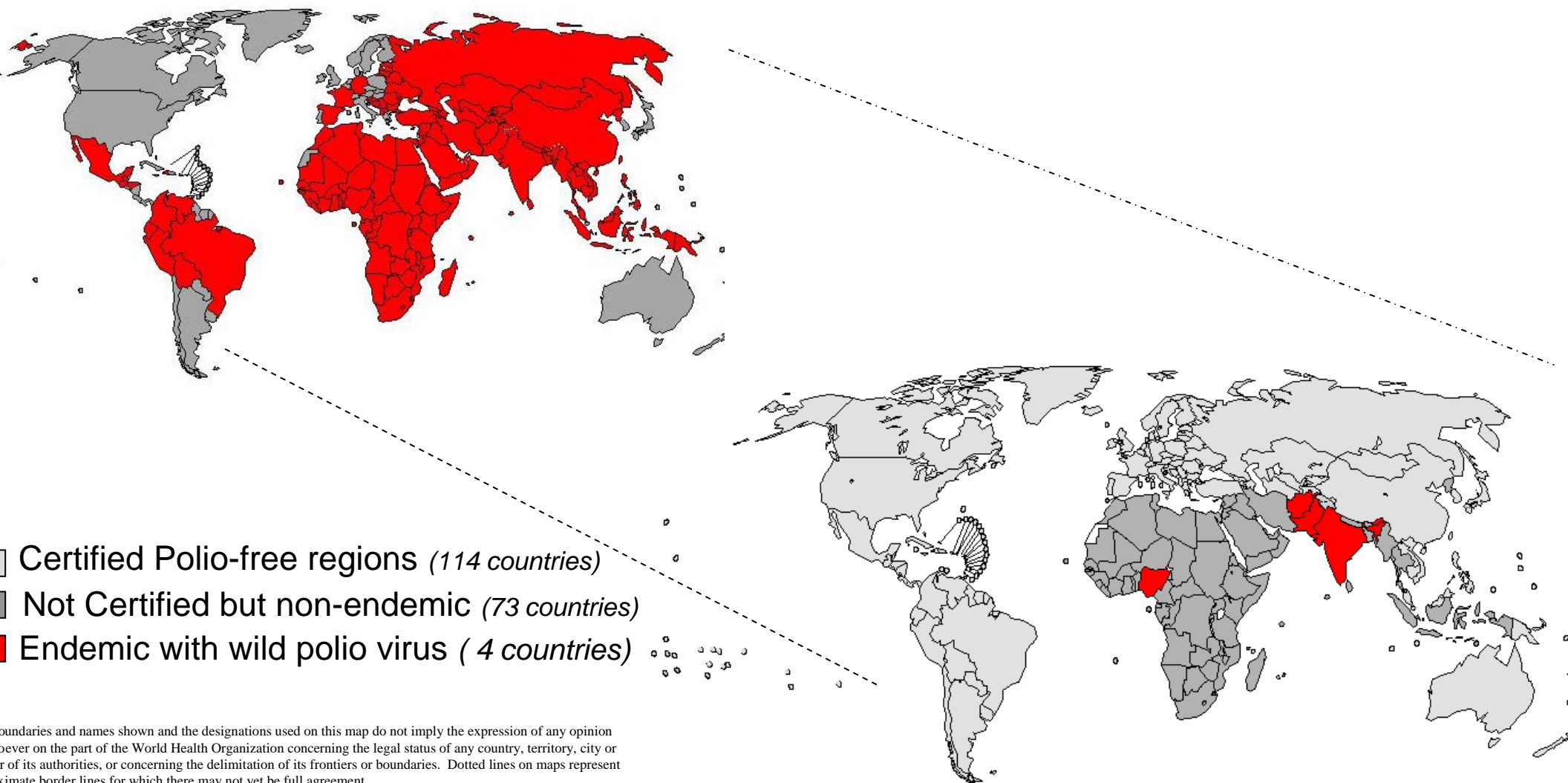

Polio Eradication Progress, 1988 – 2010



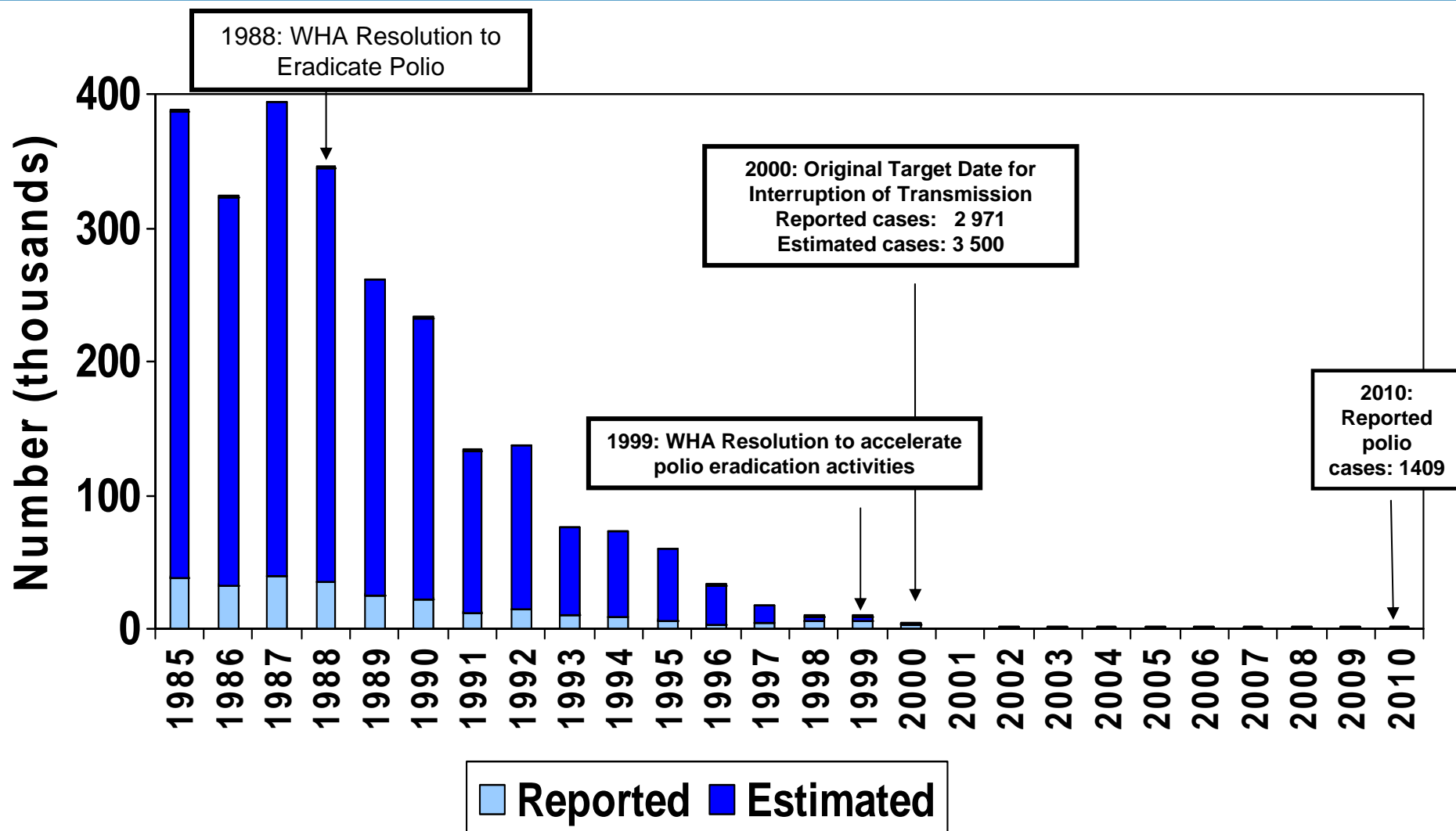

Progress in Polio Eradication, Estimated and Reported Polio Cases, 1985-2010



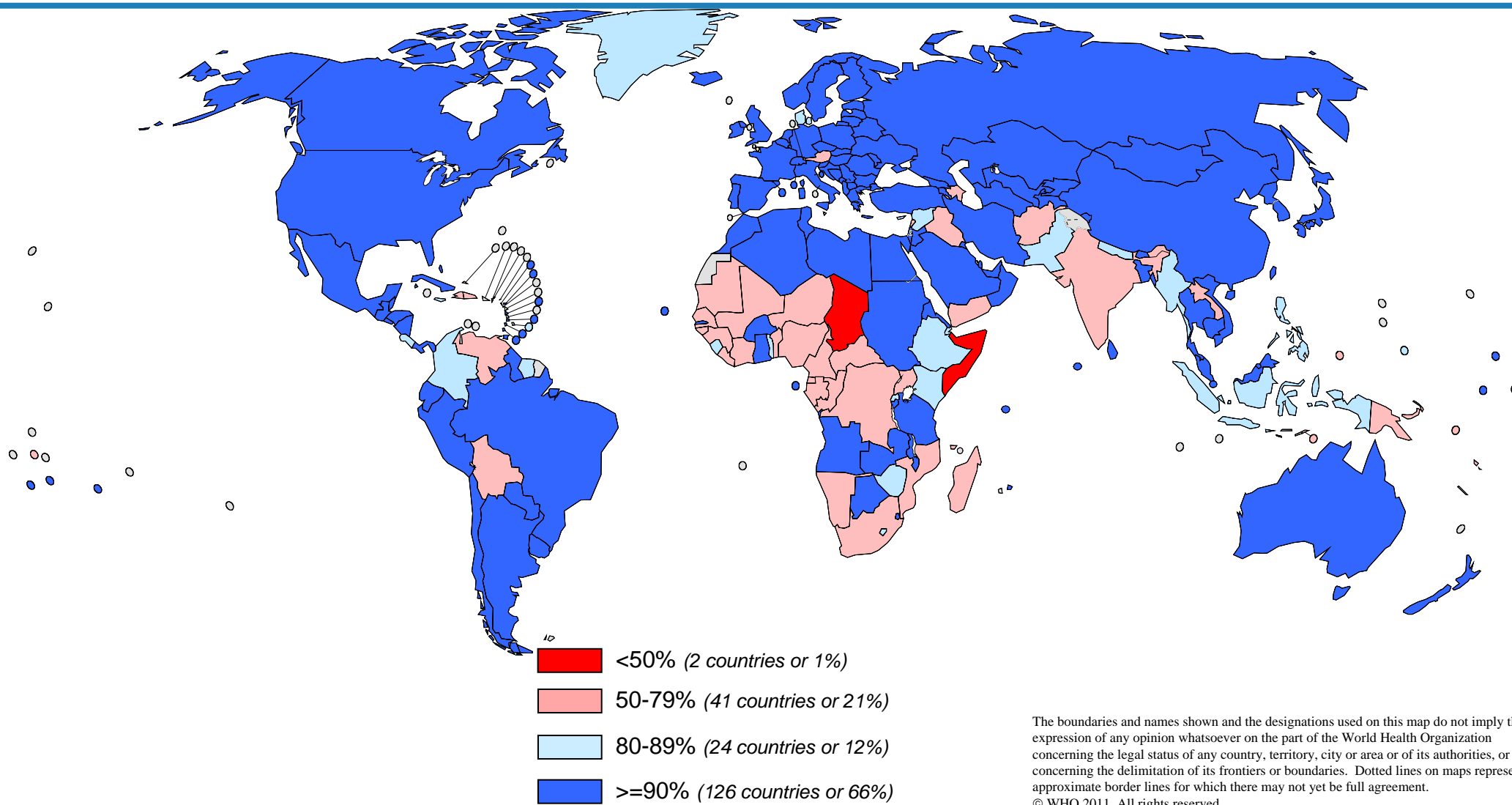

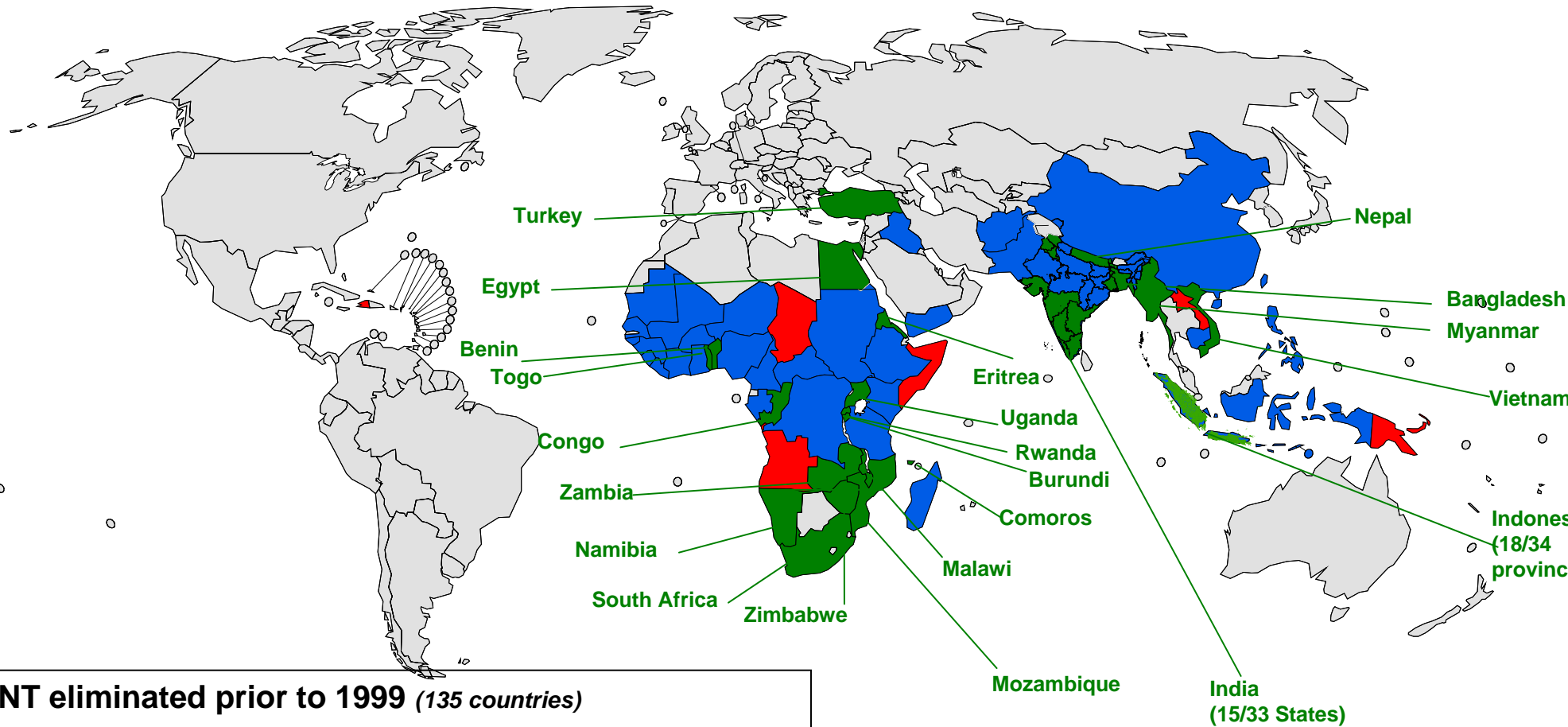

Immunization coverage with measles containing vaccines in infants, 2010



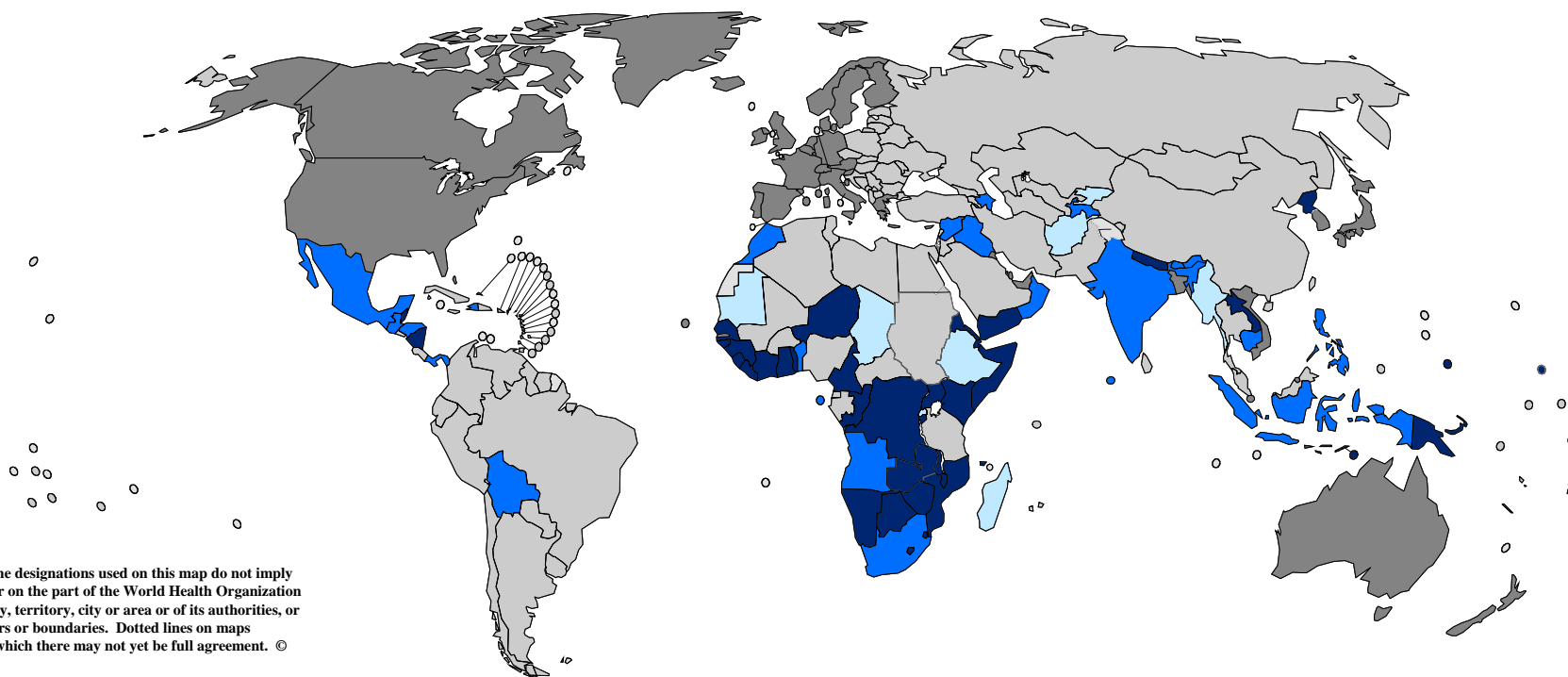

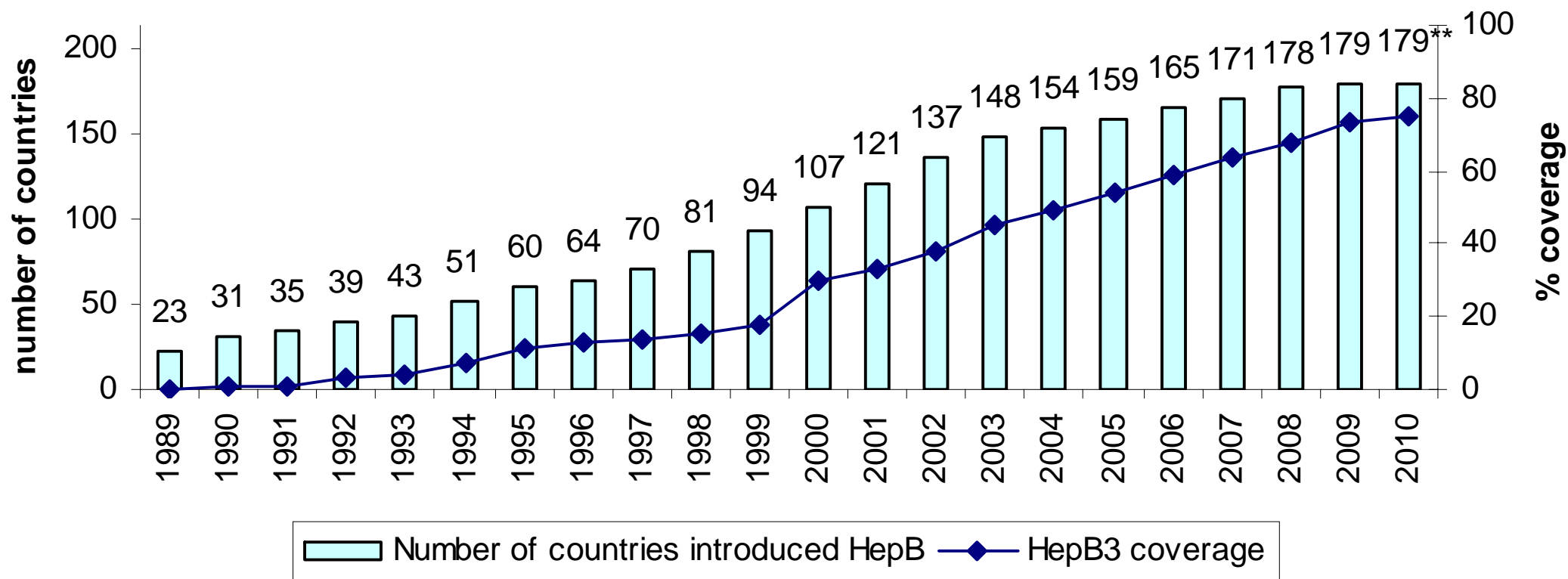
- Vitamin A distributed with routine and supplementary immunization activities (38 countries or 25%)

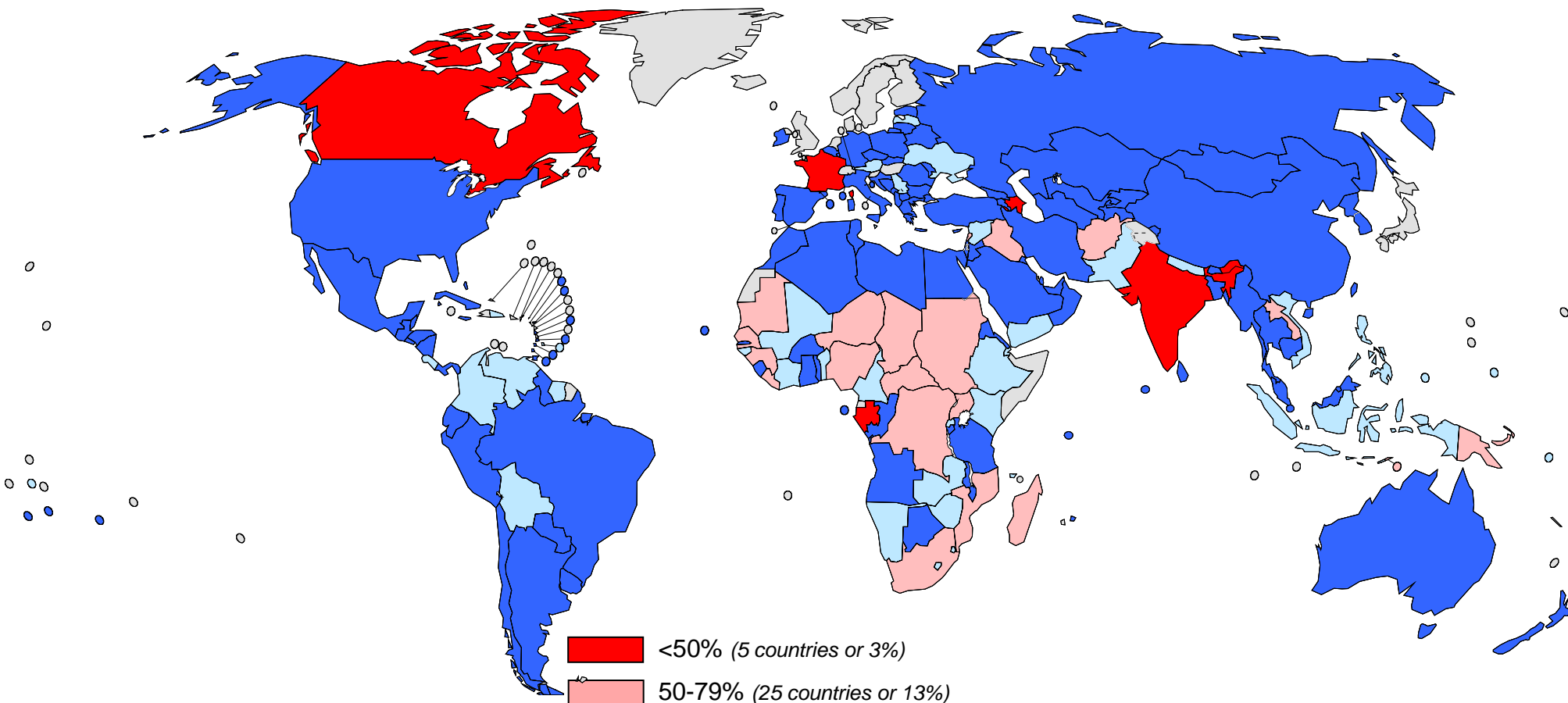

Immunization coverage with 3rd dose of HepB vaccines in infants, 2010

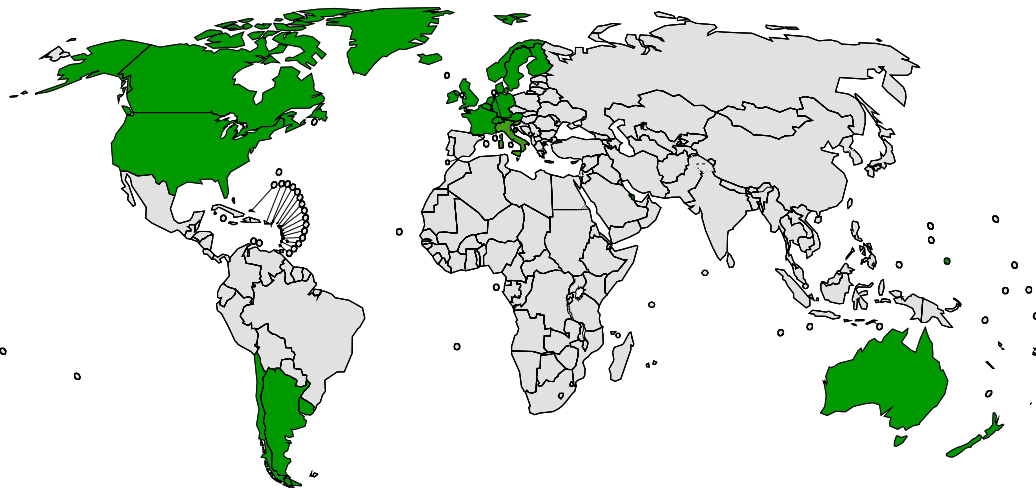

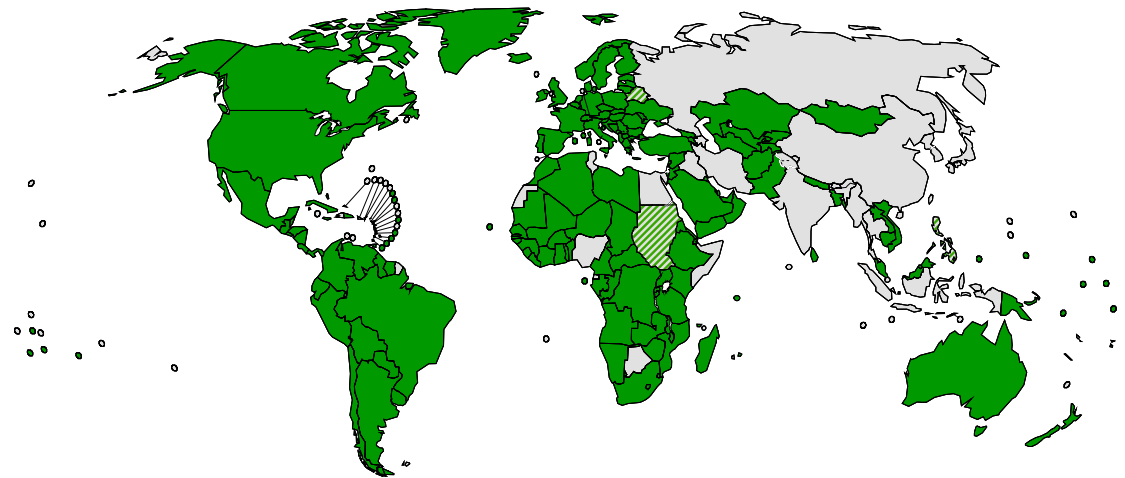

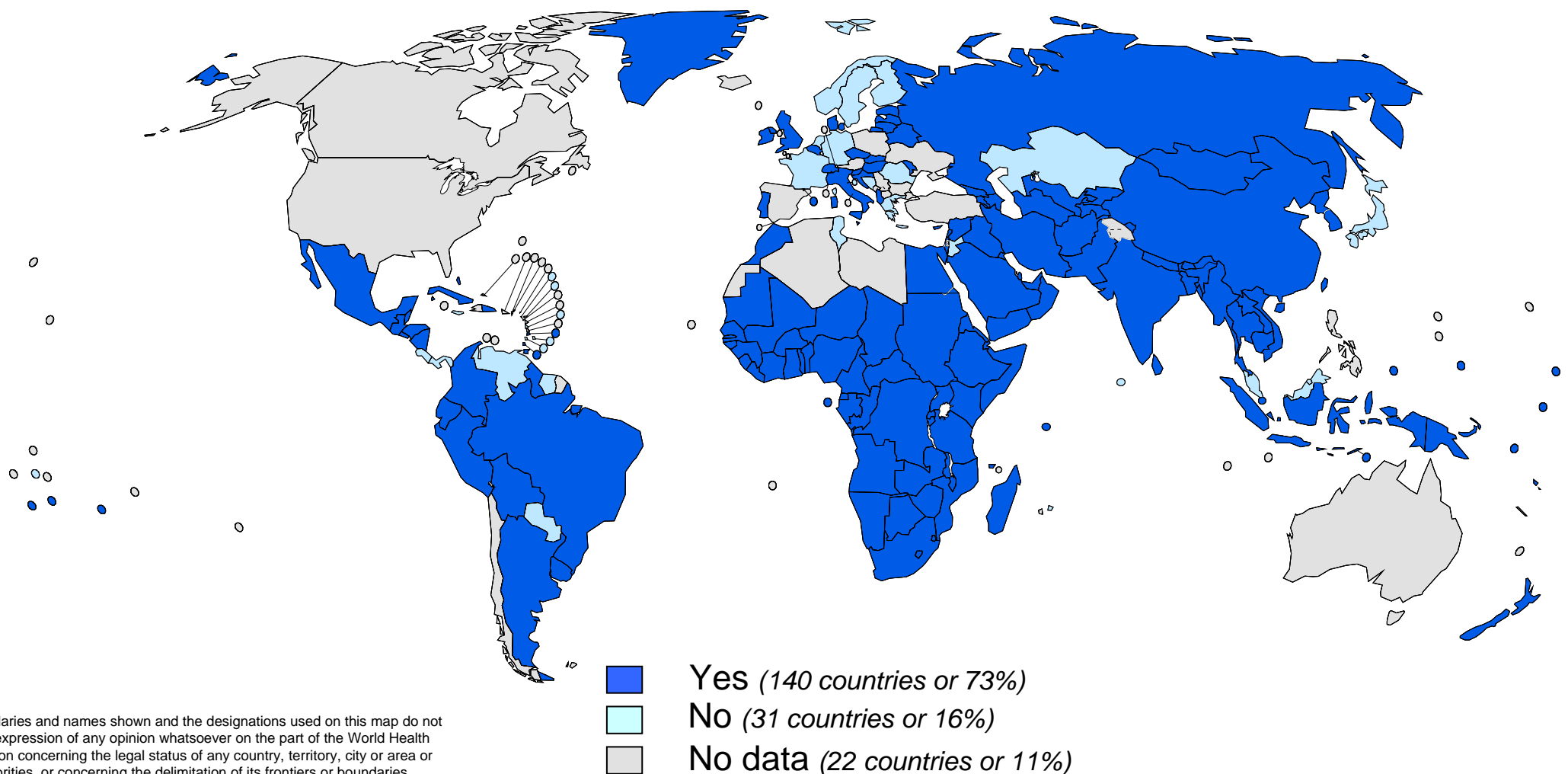

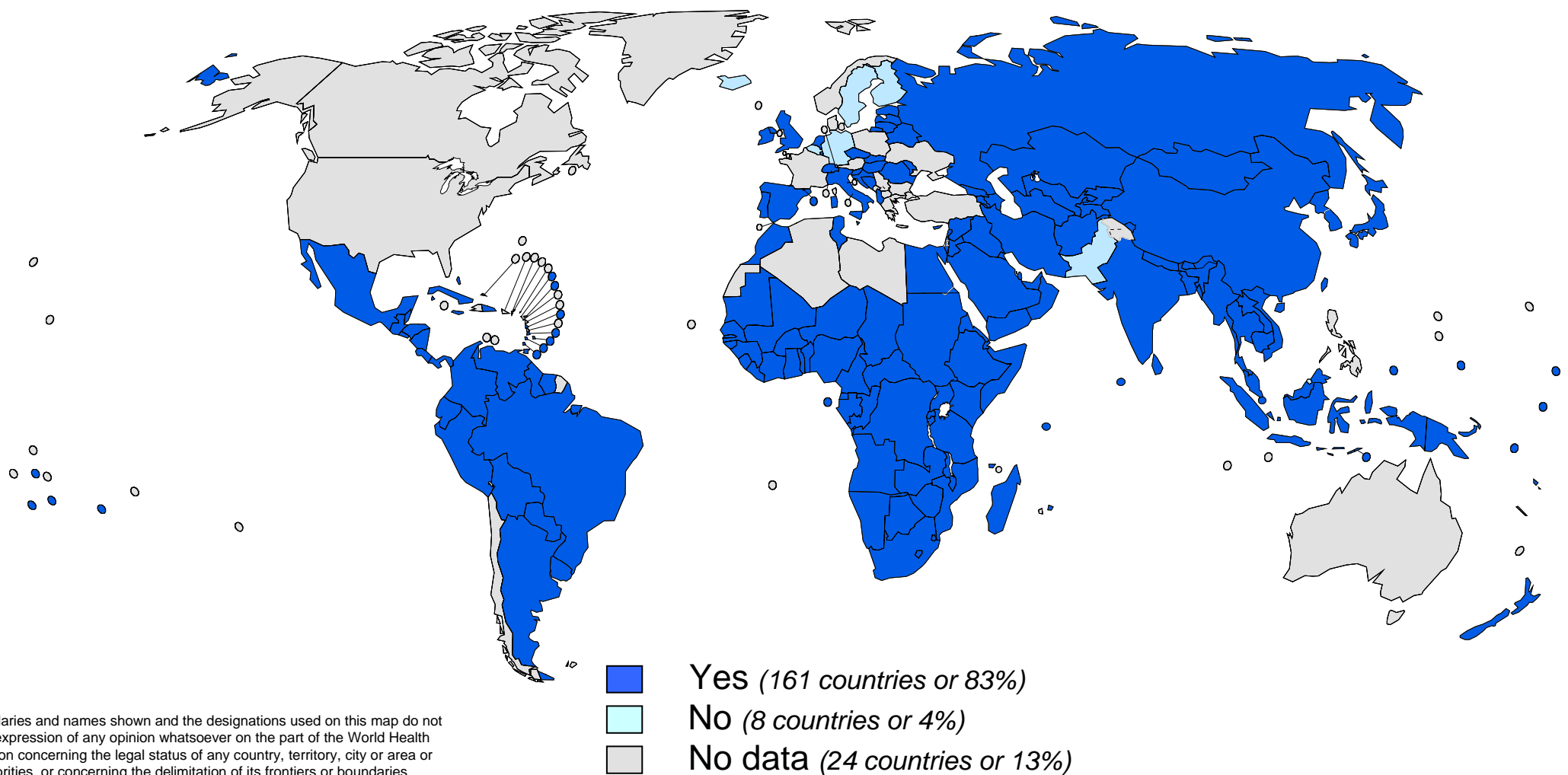

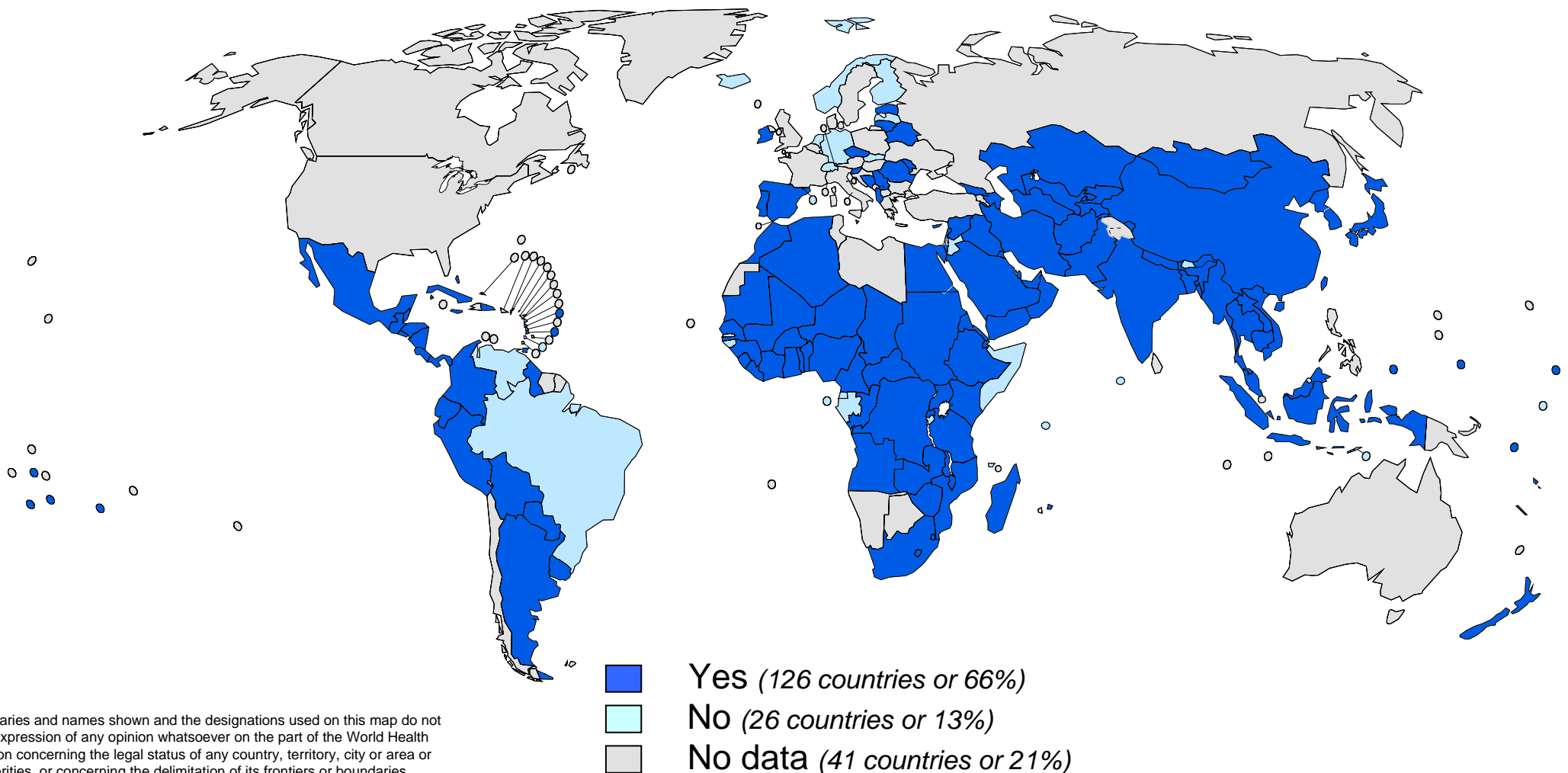
