

WHO Global Observatory on Health Research and Development (R&D)

(the “Observatory”)

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The Global Observatory on Health R&D is a global-level initiative that aims to help identify health R&D priorities based on public health needs. It does so by consolidating, monitoring and analysing relevant information on the health R&D needs of developing countries; building on existing data collection mechanisms; and supporting coordinated actions on health R&D.

The Observatory aims to be a comprehensive source of information and analyses on global health R&D activities. It builds on existing data and reports from a wide range of data sources, gathering new information where needed and feasible.
