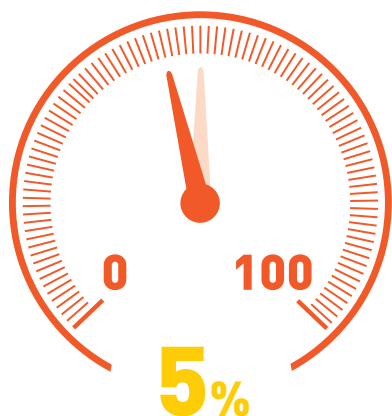


SPEED: THE FACTS



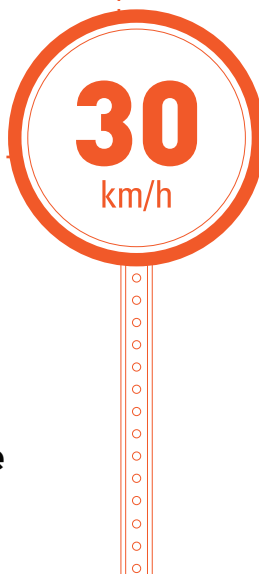
A 5% cut in average speed can result in...

30%

reduction in the number of fatal crashes.



When motorized traffic mixes with pedestrians and cyclists, the speed limit should be under 30km/h.

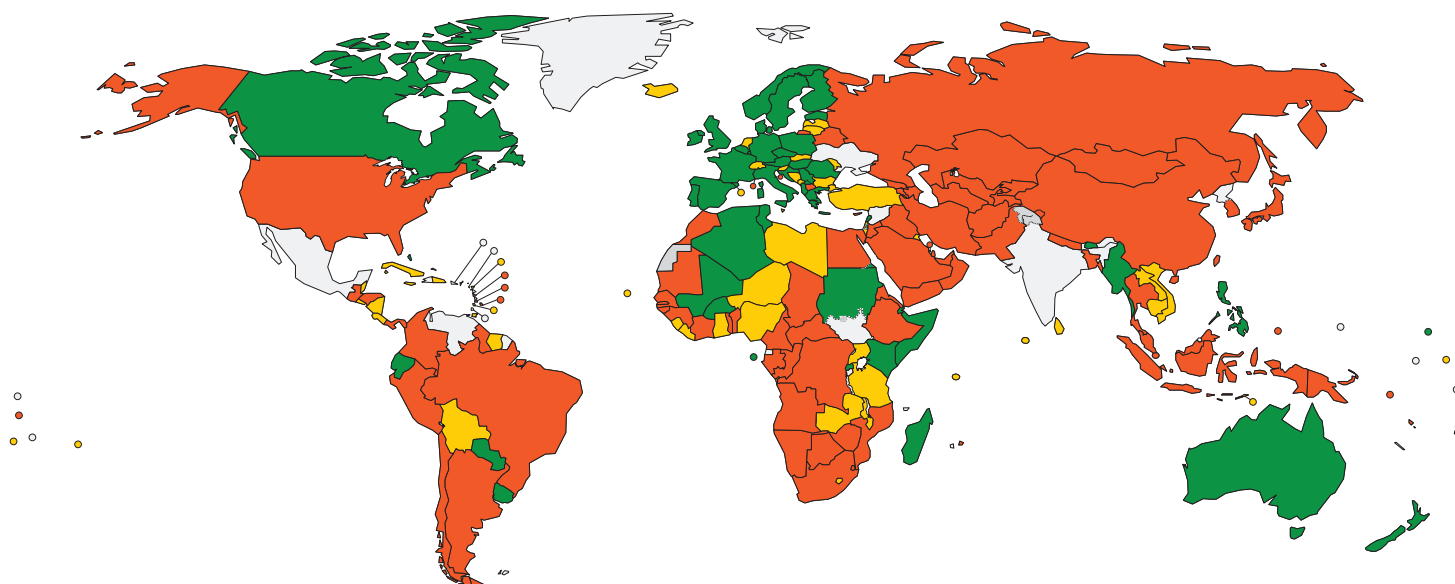


have implemented an urban speed limit of 50km/h or less...

Urban speed laws by country



- Speed limits on urban roads \leq 50 km/h and can be modified
- Speed limits on urban roads \leq 50 km/h but cannot be modified
- No speed law or speed limit on urban roads $>$ 50 km/h
