

4. *Enforcement of laws relating to key risk factors for road traffic injuries is poor in many countries.*

Enforcement of road safety laws is often lacking. For example, when asked to self-rate their law enforcement performance on a scale of 0 to 10:

- 9% of countries report the enforcement of speed limits as over 7.
- 13% of countries report the enforcement of blood alcohol concentration limits as over 7.
- 25% of countries report the enforcement of their motorcycle helmet-use laws as over 7.
- 19% of countries report the enforcement of their seat-belt laws as over 7.
- 6% of countries report the enforcement of their child restraint laws as over 7.
