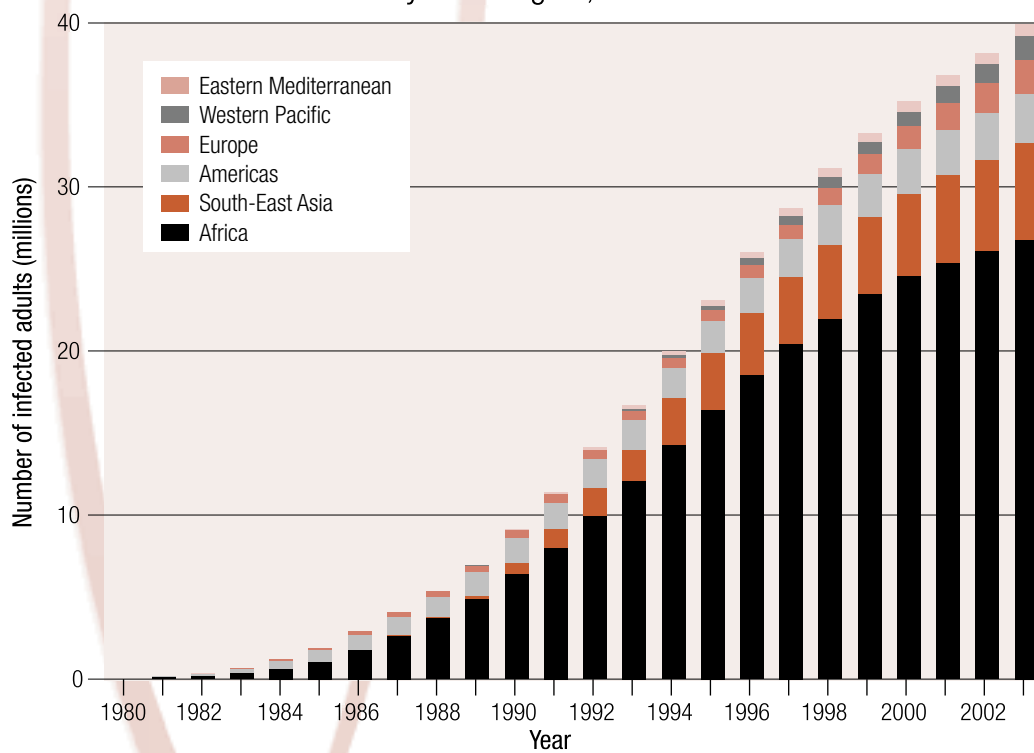

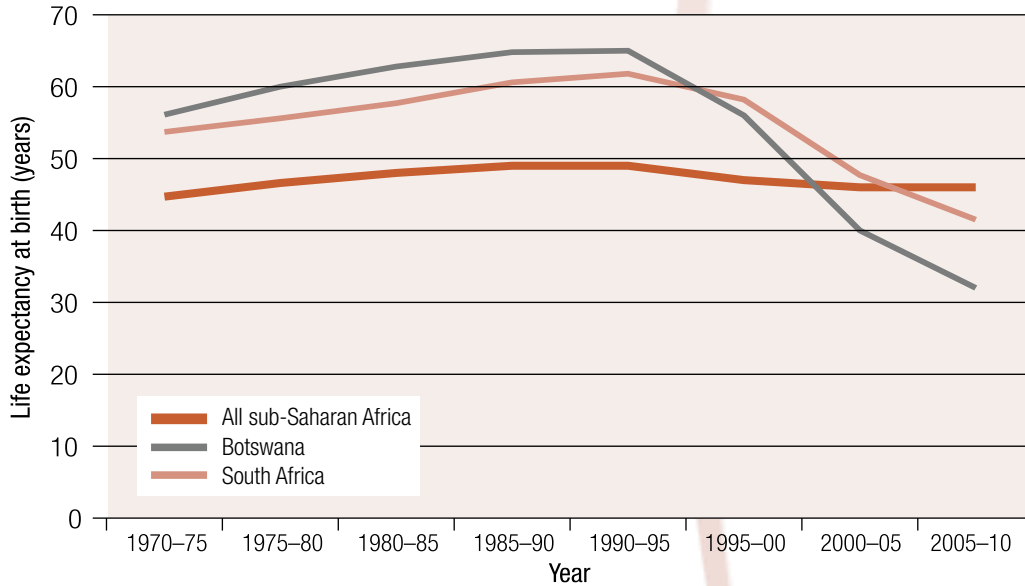
THE GLOBAL IMPACT OF HIV/AIDS

by WHO region, 1980–2003

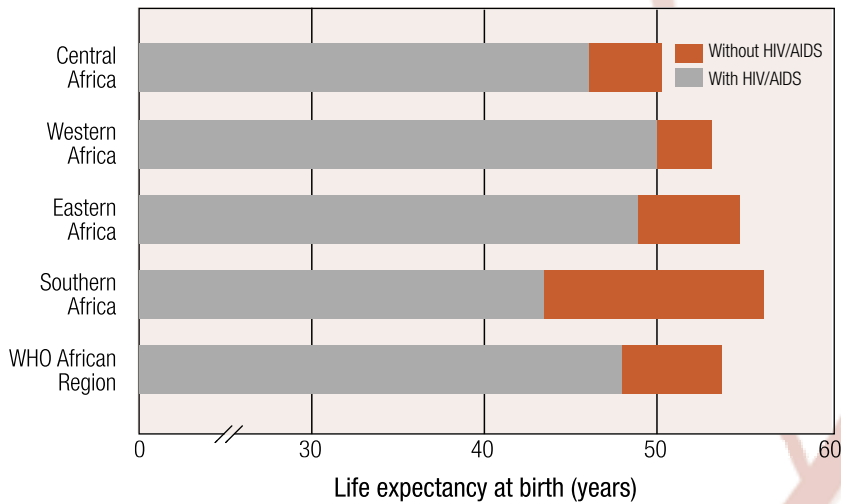


THE IMPACT OF HIV/AIDS IN AFRICA

Trends in life expectancy in sub-Saharan Africa and two selected countries, 1970–2010

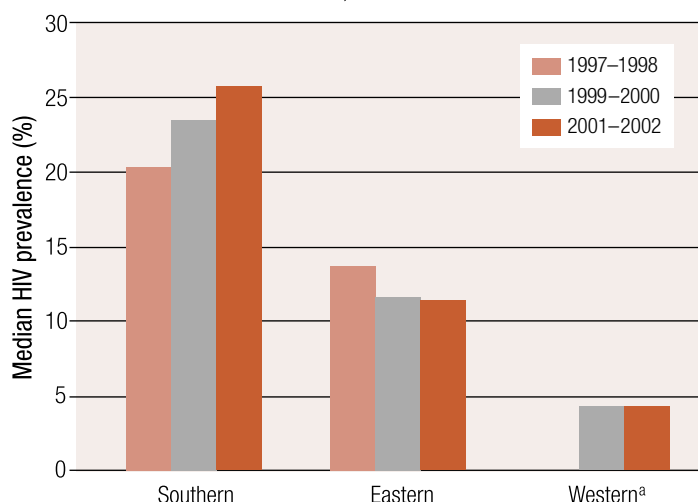


Life expectancy in Africa, with and without HIV/AIDS, 2002



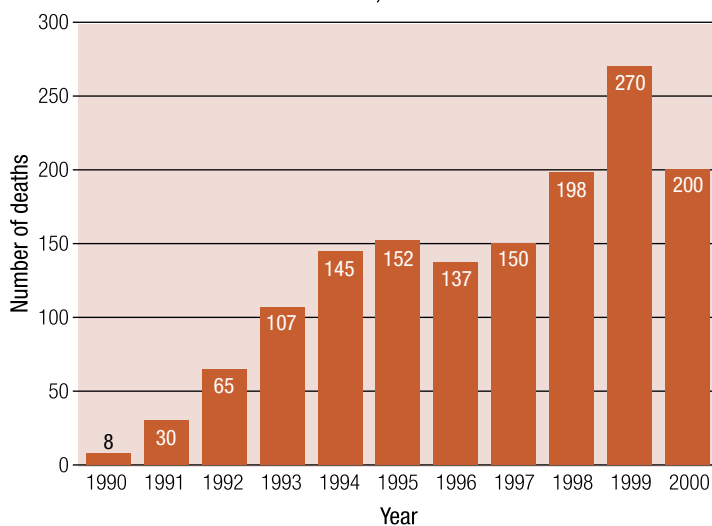

HIV prevalence among pregnant women attending antenatal clinics in areas of sub-Saharan Africa, 1997–2002



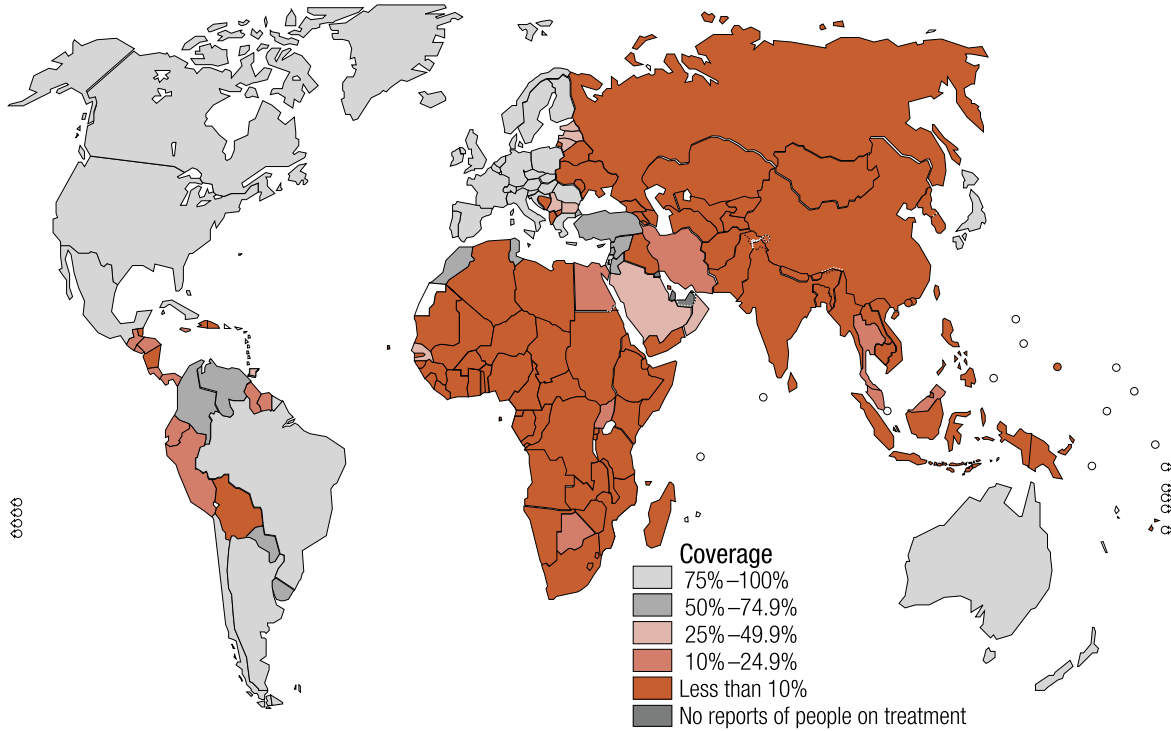

Deaths from HIV/AIDS among health workers in Malawi, 1990–2000



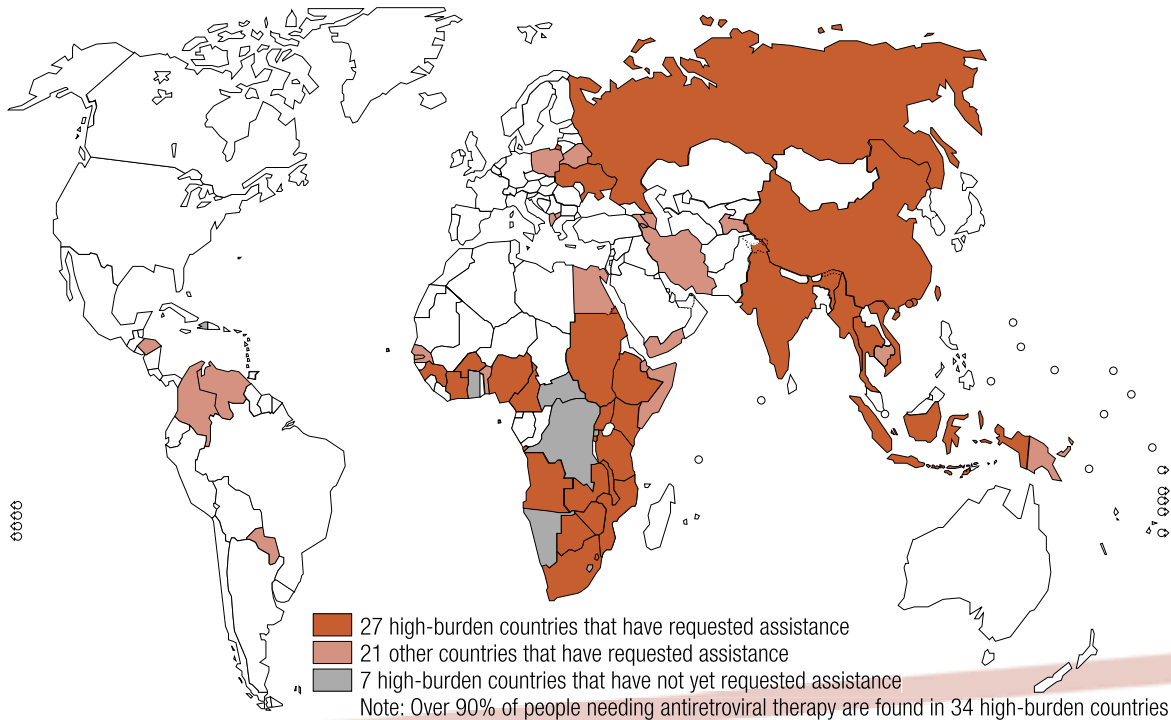
HIV/AIDS: THE TREATMENT GAP

HIV/AIDS: 3 BY 5 INITIATIVE

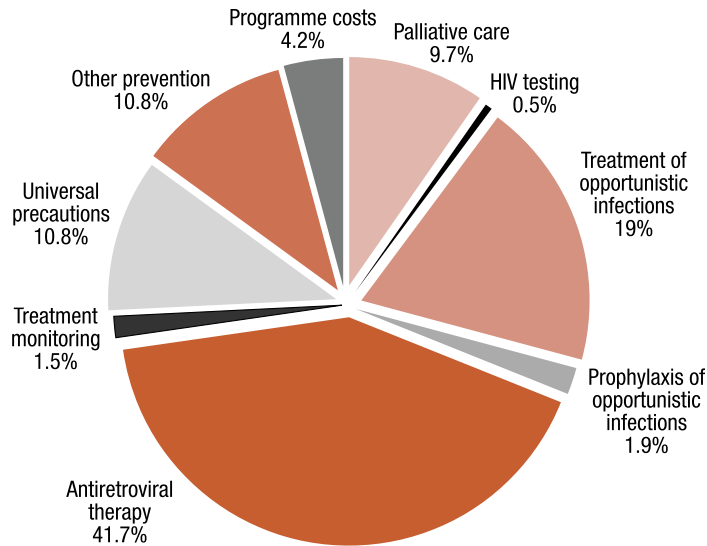
Countries that have requested assistance under the 3 by 5 initiative, as of 3 March 2004

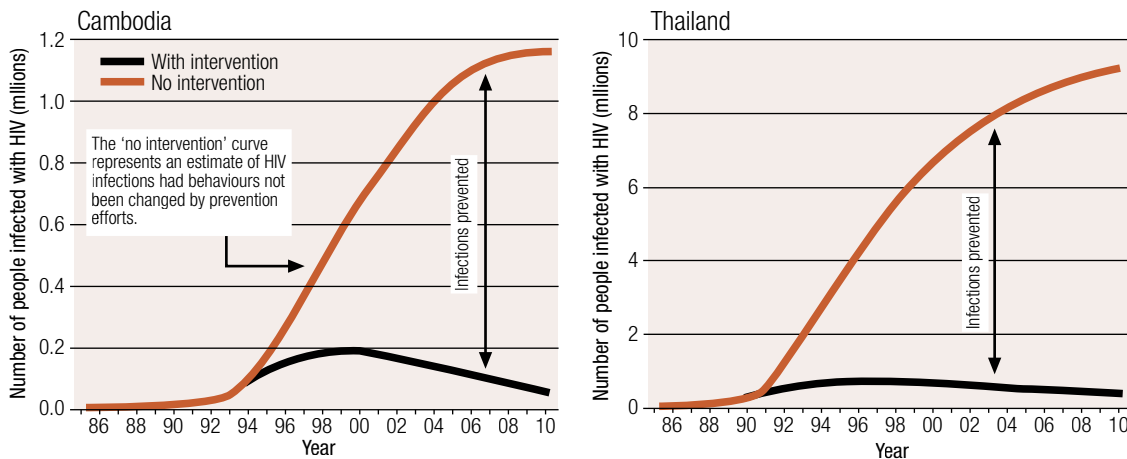
HIV/AIDS: 3 BY 5 INITIATIVE
