Monthly Situation Update

October 2020

Highlights

- As of 31 October, over 300 million units of PPE, tests and biomed equipment have been delivered to destination countries.
- As markets are improving and logistics constraints diminishing, WFP is phasing down the free-to-user cargo services and the Emergency Service Marketplace (ESM) platform has been closed. Following extensive consultation with partners to determine current and prospective pipeline, WFP is planning the dispatches of the remaining cargo, foreseen to be completed by the end of 2020.
- An independent review of the COVID-19 Supply Chain System (CSCS) is ongoing to assess the mechanism the processes and the achievements vis-à-vis the response.

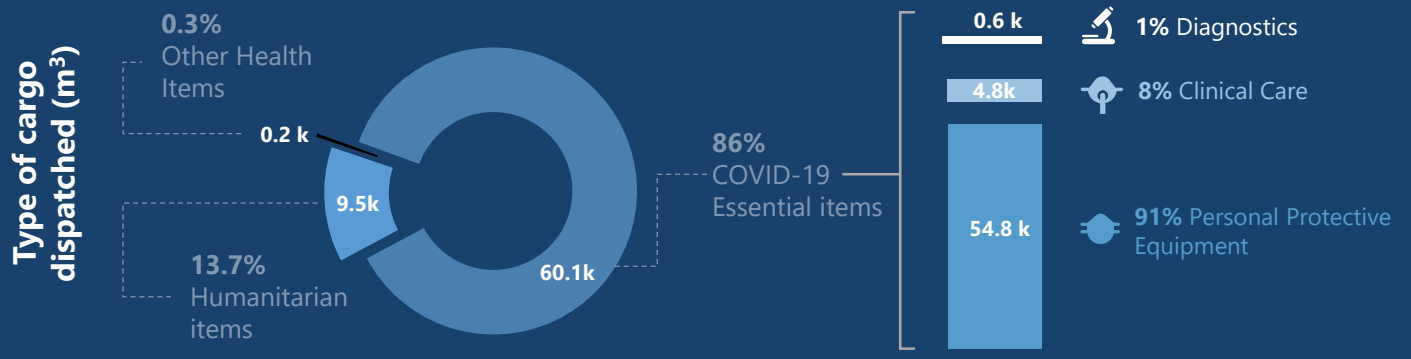
