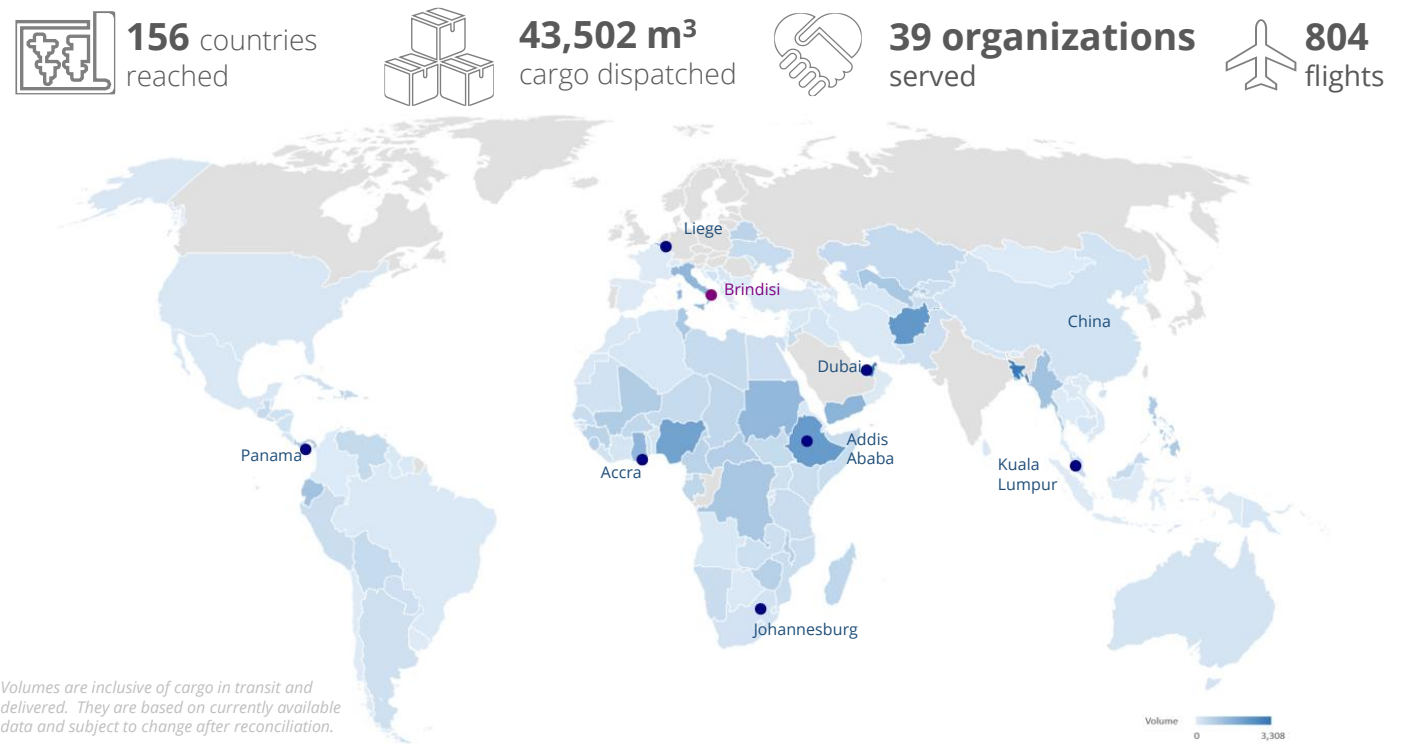

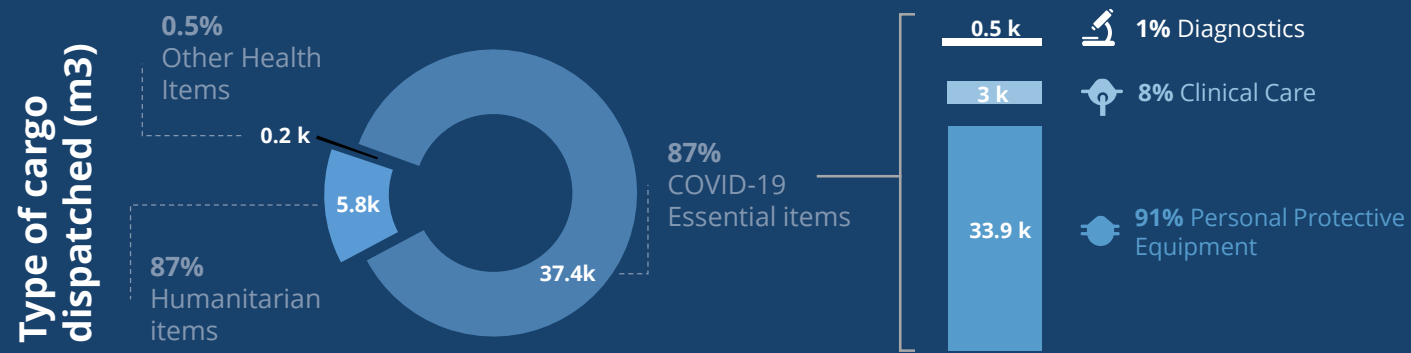
Highlights

- A Data Dashboard for the COVID-19 Supply Chain was launched in August, providing an improved visibility on the demand, procurement and deliveries.
- Around USD 330 million worth of essential items has been delivered to 165 countries, with another USD 100 million worth of items either already in transit, or about to be shipped.
- As of 1 September, the Diagnostics consortium reported as delivered around 15 million tests, of which 11 million manual tests and 3.5 million automated. Over 500,000 tests are in transit, and another 2 million are being prepared for shipment. A significant volume was delivered in the Latin America region thanks to a PAHO procurement for about 10 million tests for Brazil.
- Recorded demand is extracted from the Supply Portal and integrated with data from supplying agencies (WHO, UNICEF, UNOPS, IOM, The Global Fund). Procurement, allocations and delivery data is gathered in the PPE, Diagnostics and Clinical Care consortia and integrated with data from the same supplying agencies.
