

# COVID-19 | Supply Chain Inter-Agency Coordination Cell

## Weekly Situational Update

3-9 August 2020

### Highlights

- Weekly dispatches of essential medical items continue at pace, this week 55 countries were reached across all WHO regions.
- Dispatches of oxygen concentrators doubled over the last week from 1,012 to 2,240.
- Quantities validated into the Supply Portal, which amount to a value of USD 130 million are coming to the planned delivery phase: approximately 3,000 m<sup>3</sup> of PPE being prepared for shipment.

### Consortia updates



#### Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

- 501 million units have been purchased.
- 329 million units are being shipped.
- 92 million units have been delivered to affected countries.



#### Diagnostics

- 18 million manual test and 2 million automated tests have been purchased.
- Vast majority of the received demand is being shipped.



#### Biomedical equipment

- 31 million units have been purchased
- 8 million units are being shipped.
- 9 million units have been delivered to affected countries.

Figures include volumes secured through the consortium, as well as quantities purchased and allocated directly by the supplying agencies.
