# Global Annual Assessment on Sanitaton and Drinking-Water 2008

#### Preamble

This questionnaire is designed to collect data for a dual purpose. First of all, it is serving the UN-Water Global Annual Assessment on Sanitation and Drinking-Water (GLASS). At the same time it is combined with the special mapping study of the Africa Working Group (AWG) of the European Union Water Initiative (EUWI) (see also the cover letter to this questionnaire for more background information). To this effect, the questionnaire has a global scope but we have added (where appropriate) specific questions related to the aid to Africa. This version of the questionnaire is sent to a pilot group of external support agencies.

We acknowledge that aid of some donors is reported to the Creditor Reporting System of the OECD-DAC (CRS). However, the scope of this questionnaire goes beyond that of the OECD-DAC's system. The aim of this exercise is to gather more detailed past and future projections of your assistance and policy changes. Your answers can differ from the CRS reports since you should not be constrained by OECD-DAC purpose-coding system. Estimations or well-informed opinions are welcomed. If you cannot answer questions or parts of the questionnaire, please provide an approximate amount or range and explain what are the main constrains for that specific question. It is better to have a few answers based on professional judgement than not to have any. For purposes of validation, please consider providing references to existing documents when these are being used as the source of information. Please feel free to add also other comments or suggestions in the appropriate boxes.

The questionnaire is accompanied by guidance notes and glossary. It is strongly recommended to read these notes first, before answering the questions (furthermore, references to relevant information in the guidance notes and glossary can be found along the main text of this questionnaire).
