

## Brunei Darussalam

Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Situation Report Bi-weekly report for the week ending 27 November 2022

### Situation summary

#### Week 46 and 47 (14 November - 27 November 2022)

- As of 27 November 2022, Brunei Darussalam reported a total of 257 921 COVID-19 cases and 143 deaths from COVID-19 since the start of the pandemic.
- Brunei Darussalam reported 9060 new COVID-19 cases in the past two weeks, a 16% increase compared to the previous 14 days.
- Brunei Darussalam currently has five (5) case in the intensive care unit (ICU), with an ICU utilization rate of 5.8%.
- In the past 14 days, six (6) new COVID-19 death was reported. One (1) death was reported in the previous two- week period. The overall case fatality rate is 0.05%.
- As of 27 November 2022, 78.8% of the total population has received a third COVID-19 vaccine dose under the National COVID-19 Vaccination Programme.
- In recent weeks, the number of new COVID-19 cases and COVID-19 deaths have increased. The COVID-19 ICU usage remains relatively low.

## **Epidemiological summary**

- As of 27 November 2022, a total of 257 921 confirmed cases and 143 deaths from COVID-19 have been reported in Brunei Darussalam.
- In the past 14 days:
  - o A total of 9060 new cases were reported.
  - o The 14-day incidence was 1971 cases per 100 000 population.

**Fig. 1.** Number of reported bi-weekly COVID-19 cases, Brunei Darussalam, from week 47 2021 to week 47 2022


