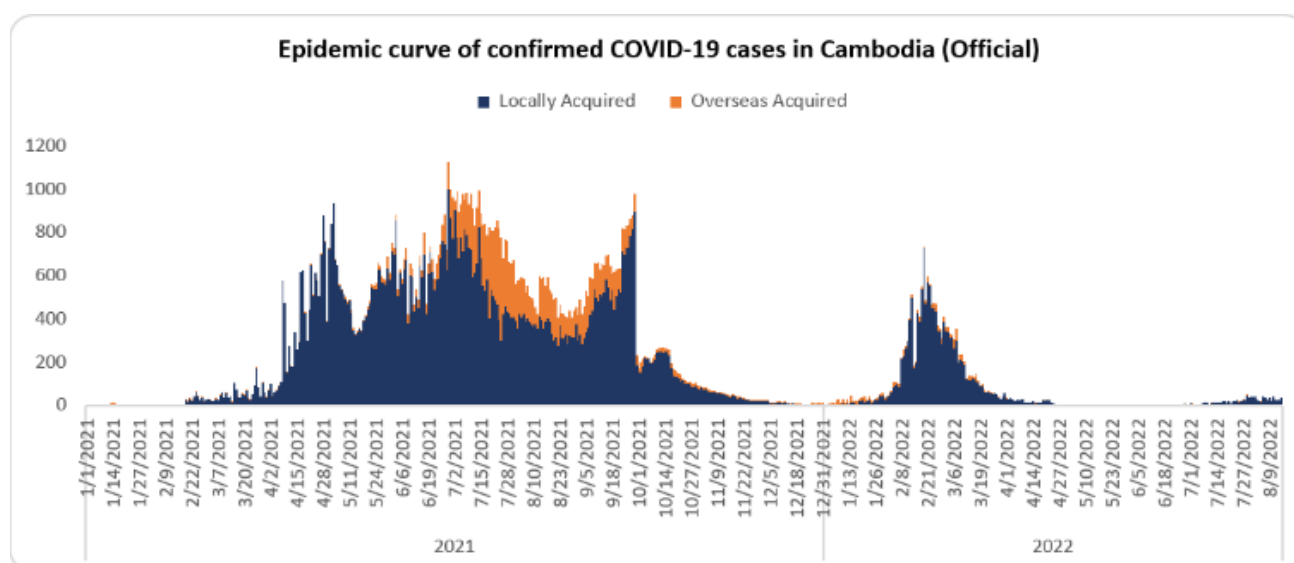


Highlights (11 July – 14 August 2022)*

- Between 11 July and 14 August, 902 new RT-PCR confirmed COVID-19 cases were reported in Cambodia. All of these cases were locally acquired.
- As of 15 August 2022, a total of 137,300 confirmed cases of COVID-19 and 3,056 deaths have been reported from Cambodia since 27 January 2020, of which 133,982 have recovered.
- As of 15 August 2022, a total of 2,650,691 tests have been performed using reverse-transcriptase polymerase chain reaction (RT-PCR) in Cambodia. 14,708 RT-PCR tests were performed between 11 July and 14 August.
- As of 19 August 2022, 44 million doses of COVID-19 vaccine were administered to the eligible group of 3 years old and above. 90.5 % of total population completed the primary series (two doses) and 62.1% received at least one dose of booster dose.
- Cambodia continues to experience a small increase in case numbers and clusters. There is however no evidence of an increase in healthcare utilization or a strain on the healthcare system. No COVID-19 death has been reported since 20 April 2022.
- COVID-19 sustained management is important; in particular refocusing efforts on multisource surveillance including testing strategies for detection and monitoring spread, promoting infection prevention control in healthcare facilities, having a subnational PHSM strategy of 'what' additional PHSM may be required and 'when' and continuing vaccination efforts with a focus on those at high-risk of severe disease and high-risk of infection. Monitoring the 'red line' in hospitals also remains key during this period of increase in cases.
