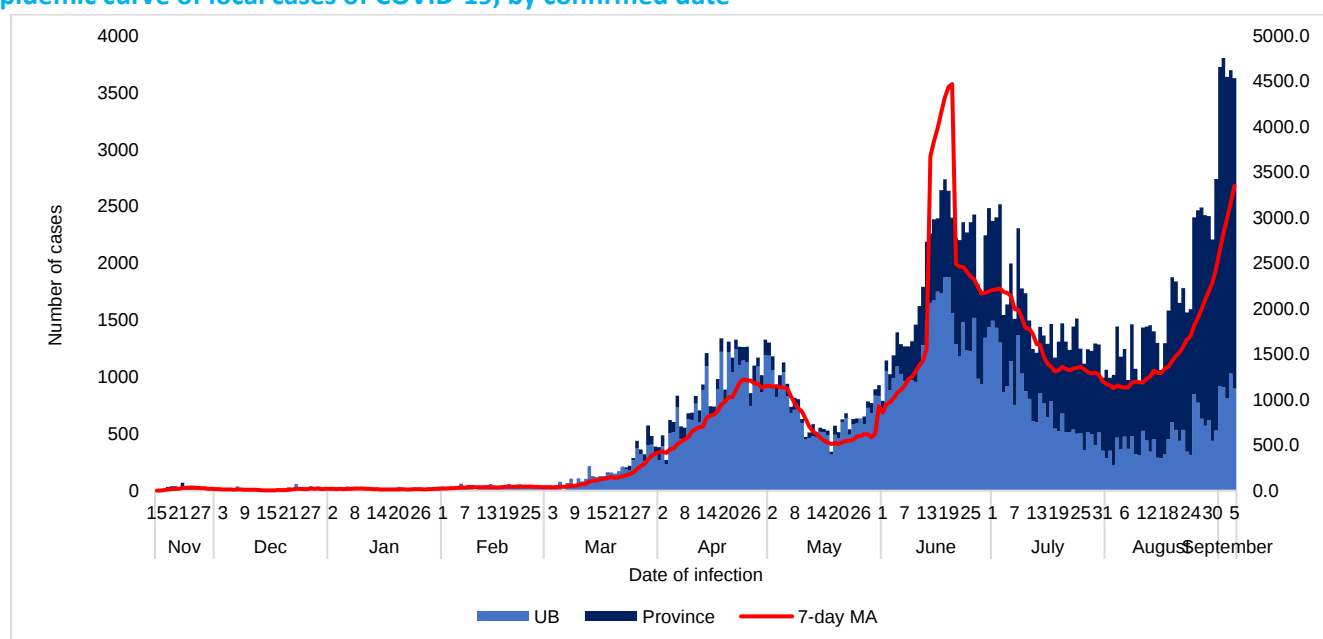


Situation summary in Mongolia

- 23,440 cases and 35 deaths were newly confirmed in the past week.
- 5528 new cases were confirmed in UB and 17,912 cases were confirmed in all 21 provinces in the past seven days.
- 11,212 close contacts were identified, of which 8,673 (77.4%) is family, 153 (1.4%) workplaces, 210 (3.1%) relatives. There were also 2103 unlinked close contacts.
- Mild 13437, moderate 4572, severe 1335 and 245 critical cases are under medical treatment
- HCWs infection is 2.1% (4833 cases) of all of the confirmed cases. 82 (49.1%) of 167 new cases in the past week is community acquired infections.

Epidemic curve of local cases of COVID-19, by confirmed date

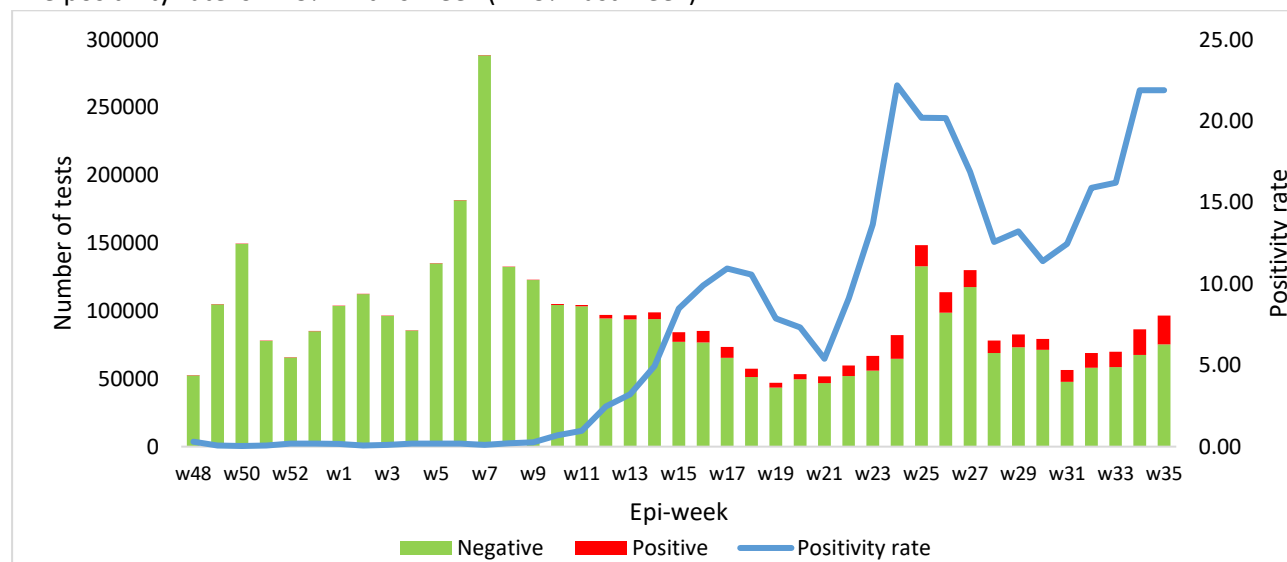

Immunization

- As of 03 September 2021, the coverage of 1st dose is 95.1% (2,242,107), 2nd dose – 89.2% (2,101,972) in the target population.
- 95,749 people vaccinated 3rd dose of AstraZeneca vaccine in Ulaanbaatar city and 21 provinces.
- There are 83.4% (1,965,688) citizens who have been vaccinated against the 2nd for 15 days or more, and 90.8% (949,029) in the capital city and 79.3% (1,016,659) in provinces and rural areas.
- Since the start of vaccination, 96,607 (2%) vaccinated people have been confirmed to be infected with the coronavirus

NPIs

- The Wedding Palace reopened since 1 Sep. 150 weddings booked for September are now being cancelled until 31 October.
- The 2021-22 academic year organized according to a 5/9 regimen (5 days physical and 9 days virtual). The government is planning to conduct early detection, active surveillance among children. Random 5-10 individual children shall be picked for testing from each grade. Rapid Response team with 3 members working in each school and kindergartens. The regulation states that if any infection is confirmed in a classroom, the entire class will attend virtual lessons for 2 weeks. For classes with children aged 4-5, classroom attendance will be capped at 20 (plus or minus 5). 2-3-year-old children are not enrolled in kindergarten. If multiple classrooms have cases, the entire floor will be closed, and students will attend virtual lessons. If other floors or buildings also have outbreaks, the entire kindergarten shall have virtual classes.
- The regular cabinet meeting held on 25 August, in the meeting alert Level II extended nationwide until 31 December 2021.
 - **Restrictions for public services** ○ Demonstrations, competitions, gatherings; weddings, funeral meals, receptions; karaoke, exhibitions, video game centers, training centers, art and culture; cinema and theatre; recreational centers e.g. religious ceremonies, temples, shrines, churches; all sports training activities except Olympic and international competition preparation (10+ people indoors);
 - Large markets, restaurants, hotel, resorts, sauna and cinema have resumed operation

- Syndromic surveillance and mask use has been implemented in all public places, businesses, workplaces and health facilities
