




Situation summary in Mongolia

- 726 cases and 0 death confirmed in the past week
- 417 cases confirmed in UB, and 309 cases confirmed in all 21 provinces in the past seven days
- Mild 24, moderate 131, severe 58, and 14 critical cases are under medical treatment
- HCWs infection is 1.7% (15,640 cases) of all the confirmed cases.

Epidemic curve of local cases of COVID-19, by the confirmed date







Immunization

- As of 03 April 2022, the coverage of 1st dose is 96.4% (2,272,439), 2nd dose 92.2% (2,174,613) in the target population.
- In Ulaanbaatar and 21 provinces, 1,032,876 and 115,185 people were vaccinated with the 3rd and 4th doses of AstraZeneca and Pfizer.
- Since the start of vaccination 459,679 (8%) vaccinated people have been confirmed to be infected with the coronavirus.

PHSM

- Heightened state of alert level II has been reduced to level I start from 14 Feb 2022 except for vaccinations, wearing masks, and social distancing:
 - o Restaurants, bars, and cafes with designated premises are open until 05:00 am
 - Dedicated shops and restaurants can operate 24/7
- 10 soums of 8 provinces with PoE are in alert level II.
- Educational activities started from 14 Feb. In addition, the process of enrolling 2-year-old children in kindergartens is starting.
- All travelers no need pre-travel test max 72 hours before departure since 14 March. No quarantine required for all travelers
