## Overall strategy


The World Health Organization (WHO) Regional Office for the Western Pacific (The Regional Office) encourages Member States to continue to suppress transmission of COVID-19 in order to avoid exceeding health systems capacities and protect vulnerable populations. A risk-based approach using the following tools is recommended: COVID-19 vaccination, calibrated public health and social measures, strengthened health system capacity, early detection and targeted response, and international border measures.

### Key highlights

- New cases of COVID-19 were reported in 20 countries or areas in the Western Pacific Region (WPR) within the past seven days (Australia 224 144, Brunei Darussalam 55, Cambodia 57, China 1 586, Fiji 2 139, French Polynesia 92, Guam 207, Japan 4 478, the Republic of Korea 28 736, Lao People's Democratic Republic (PDR) 6 211, Malaysia 23 053, Mongolia 2 114, New Caledonia 207, New Zealand 414, Northern Mariana Islands 429, Palau 3, Papua New Guinea 59, the Philippines 22 069, Singapore 3 187, and Viet Nam 119 719).
- Seven countries or areas in the WPR that had previously reported cases have reported no new cases within the past seven days: (American Samoa (26 days), Marshall Islands (413 days), Samoa (22 days), Solomon Islands (7 days), Tonga (67 days), Vanuatu (22 days), and Wallis and Futuna (243 days)).
- Eight Pacific Island countries and areas have not reported a case to date: (Cook Islands, Kiribati, Micronesia (Federated States of), Nauru, Niue, Pitcairn Islands, Tokelau, and Tuvalu).

#### Supplies and logistics for health care workers shipped to 38 destinations in the Western Pacific Region (as of 05 January 2022)





## Weekly situation updates

- In the WPR, 27 countries and areas have reported COVID-19 cases since December 2019. Between 29 December 2021 and 04 January 2022, a total of 438 959 cases with 2 835 deaths were reported, for a cumulative 11 605 208 cases with 157 502 deaths (proportion of fatal cases (PFC) 1.4%) as of 05 January 2022, 18:00 (GMT+8). Available data indicate that countries or areas in the WPR have identified imported cases or localized community transmission, while subnational areas in some WPR countries and areas have identified large-scale community transmission. Figure 1 shows the geographical distribution of cases reported in the last seven days. Updated information about transmission stage assessment (TSA) <sup>1</sup> in each Member State is available on the TSA map dashboard.
- Globally, 293 750 692 COVID-19 cases with 5 454 131 deaths have been reported in 226 countries or areas (PFC 1.9%) as of 05 January 2022 17:00 (CEST). Recent daily new cases in all six regions are increasing, with a sharp increasing trend in cases in the European Region and Region of Americas, increasing trends in the South-East Asia Region and Eastern Mediterranean Region, and a stabilization of cases in the African Region.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> 0-No cases: no cases detected and no clear signals of transmission for at least 28 days (or two incubation periods); 1-Imported cases: cases reported in the past 28 days are imported or linked to importation within 3 generations, and there are no clear signals of local transmission; 2-Localized community transmission: cases reported in the past 28 days are localized and cannot be linked to importations, though most are linked to a cluster, and there are no clear signals of large-scale community transmission; 3-Large-scale community transmission: most cases reported in the past 28 days have no known link to a cluster and are spread across the area, and there are clear signals of increasing transmission and severe outcomes.





Figure 3. Epidemic curve of confirmed COVID-19 cases in countries or areas with the lowest number of cases, as of 05 January 2022 10:00 (GMT+8)

## New guidance

- On 28 December 2021, WHO headquarters published a series of posters for healthcare workers, biomedical engineers and staff of health care facilities in charge of cleaning, decontaminating and sterilizing respiratory medical equipment in hospitals and health facilities.   - o Medical equipment related to oxygen therapy Cleaning task sequence
