Overall strategy


The World Health Organization (WHO) Regional Office for the Western Pacific (the Regional Office) encourages Member States to continue to suppress transmission of COVID-19 in order to avoid exceeding health system capacities and to protect vulnerable populations. A risk-based approach using the following tools is recommended: COVID-19 vaccination, calibrated public health and social measures, strengthened health system capacity, early detection and targeted response, and international border measures.

Key highlights

- New cases of COVID-19 were reported in 21 countries or areas in the Western Pacific Region within the past seven days: Australia 74 695, Brunei Darussalam 2168, Cambodia 43, China 334 933, Fiji 3 115, Guam 40, Japan 219 056, the Republic of Korea 147 059, Lao People's Democratic Republic (PDR) 122, Malaysia 11 108, Marshall Islands 70, Micronesia (Federated States of) 4548, Mongolia 511, New Zealand 11 019, Niue 2, Palau 21, Papua New Guinea 96, the Philippines 14 136, Singapore 40 923, Vanuatu 2, and Viet Nam 4729.
- Two Western Pacific countries or areas that had previously reported cases have reported no new cases
 within the past seven days: Tuvalu (49 days), and Pitcairn Islands (83 days). One Pacific Island country or
 area has not reported a case to date: Tokelau. American Samoa, Cook Islands, French Polynesia, Kiribati,
 Nauru, New Caledonia, Northern Mariana Islands, Samoa, Solomon Islands, Tonga, and Wallis and Futuna
 did not update the number of cases due to reporting issues.



Weekly situation updates

- In the Region, 34 countries and areas have reported COVID-19 cases since December 2019. From 5 to 11 October 2022, a total of 865 284 cases with 1442 deaths were reported, for a cumulative 91 029 222 cases with 273 061 deaths (proportion of fatal cases (PFC) 0.3%) as of 12 October, 10:00 (GMT+8). Available data indicate that countries and areas in the Region have identified imported cases and/or localized community transmission, while subnational areas in some countries and areas have identified large-scale community transmission. Figure 1 shows the geographical distribution of cases reported in the last seven days.
- Globally, 619 275 497 COVID-19 cases with 6 538 033 deaths have been reported in 233 countries or areas (PFC 1.1%) as of 11 October 2022 10:00 (CEST). The number of newly reported weekly cases decreased or remained stable across all six regions. Conversely, the number of new weekly deaths decreased or remained stable in all regions except for the Region of the Americas.





Figure 3. Epidemic curve of confirmed COVID-19 cases in countries or areas with the lowest number of cases, as of 12 October 2022 10:00 (GMT+8)
