## Providing coverage of essential health services

On a scale from 0 to 100, the European Region has improved from a score of 75 to 77



### Service capacity & access

(hospital access, density of health workers, access to medicines)

Worsened situation in 21 out of 50 countries

Improved situation in 13 out of 50 countries



94/100

Regional average unchanged at 94 out of 100

European Region, largest density of doctors globally and 2nd highest density of nurses and midwives



47 doctors per 10 000 population



82 nurses/midwives per 10 000 population



#### Maternal and child health

Worsened situation

in 13 out of 50 countries

Improved situation in 17 out of 50

86/100

Regional average unchanged at 86 out of 100



## Infectious diseases

(HIV, TB, malaria prevention)

Worsened situation in 5 out of 50 countries

Improved situation in 44 out of 50

68/100

Regional average improved from 68 to 73 out of 100







# Prevention and treatment of NCDs



No country reported a worsened situation

Improved situation in 32 out of 50



Regional average improved from 60 to 61 out of 100
