Density of active health workers per 10 000 population at subnational level

Disaggregation

By occupation

Definition

Number of active health workers per 10 000 population in the given subnational administrative unit

Potential data sources

- · Aggregate data from health facilities (routine administrative records, Health Management Information System, District Health Information System census and/or survey)
- · Professional council/chamber/association registers
- Population census data
- · Health facility database (with location)
- · United Nations Statistics Division population data

Disaggregation

By occupation

Definition

Percentage of active health workers in the given age groups, by occupation

Potential data sources

- · Health workforce registry or database
- · Aggregate data from health facilities (routine administrative records, Health Management Information System, District Health Information System census and/or survey)
- · Professional council/chamber/association registers
- · Labour force surveys
- · Population census data

Percentage of female health workers in active health workforce, by occupation

Disaggregation

By occupation and facility ownership

Definition

Percentage of active health workers employed in facilities by type of ownership (public, private not-for profit, private for-profit)

- · Aggregate data from health facilities (routine administrative records, Health Management Information System, District Health Information System census and/or survey)

Percentage of active health workers employed in the given facility type, by occupation

Share of foreign-born health workers

Name

Disaggregation

Percentage of active foreign-born health workers

By occupation

Definition

This indicator will capture the information on health workforce coming from abroad

Potential data sources

· Health workforce registry or database

- · Professional council/chamber/association registers
- · Health facility data
- Population census data (data mainly available on place of birth, not place of training)

Share of foreign-trained health workers

Name

Disaggregation

Percentage of active foreign-trained health workers By occupation, by occupation and country of training

Definition

Percentage of active foreign-trained health workers in the active health workforce

Potential data sources

- · Health workforce registry or database
- · Professional council/chamber/association registers
- · Health facility data

Share of workers across health and social sectors

Name

Percentage of workers in the health and social sector to total civilian workers

Disaggregation

Health and social sectors defined by ISIC codes 86, 87, and 88

Definition

Ratio of the number of persons working in health and social sector to the total number of persons employed in the civilian labour force. Total civilian corresponds to the total labour force excluding armed forces

Potential data sources

- · Labour force surveys
- Tax registries, insurance or pension fund registries
